 1834 latter Part pleasant
 employed in ship's duty

Thursday First Part fine weather employed
 Dec 25 getting ready for sea Middle Part
 1834 tight air Latter Part one watch
 on shore

Friday First Part pleasant at 2 PM the
 Dec 26 ship Nassau sailed for Canton
 1834 Middle Part calm Latter Part
 pleasant one watch on shore

Saturday First Part pleasant weather employed
 Dec 27 in various parts of ship's duty
 1834 Middle Part pleasant Latter Part
 employed in getting the ship ready

Sunday First Part at 2 PM left Abasco
 Dec 28 in company with the Amazon
 1834 at Fare Haven Middle Part
 under all sail steering N by N
 Latter Part fine breezes steering
 N by N the land in sight Lat 21-59 N

Monday First Part light breeze ship
 Dec 29 under N at 1 PM saw the pole
 1834 at 4 to 5 bearing N distant 4
 leagues Middle Part light
 air Latter Part pleasant Lat 23-12 N

afternoon Brought to the Coast of Peru
 Tuesday First Part at this 24 hours light
 Dec 30 breezes from the E by N ship N by N
 1834 in putting the boats and various other
 jobs Middle Part light breezes
 Latter Part pleasant at 1 PM
 saw sperm whales lowered but
 did not catch them Lat 24-05 N
 Long



Wednesday First Part saw more whales
 Dec 31 lowered but did not catch them
 1834 some embarked made all sail to
 the E at sunset took ship N by N
 Latter Part at 7 PM saw
 whales lowered showed much one
 whale and hid him Lat

 Dec 31 First Part took the whale aboard
 1835 side shortened sail Middle Part
 by the whale Latter Part
 out in the whale and saw more
 lowered but did not catch them
 Lat 24-07 N



Friday First Part pleasant employed
 Jan 1 in boiling at sunset saw a large
 1835 whale to late to lower and touched
 ship to the W Middle Part
 boiling touched ship N by N
 Latter Part pleasant made sail
 finished boiling Lat
 Long
