

Remarks on Board Ship Charles

Wednesday  
March 4  
1822  
First Part of strong breeze from the North West at 2 PM. Tacked ship to ship N. 2 ships in sight at sunset took in sail 6 leagues from the land Middle Part tacked to up N. W. Latter Part strong gales made sail saw one ship. Log

Thursday  
March 5  
1822  
First Part of this 24 hours light breeze from the N. W. at 1 PM. Tacked in anchoring the fore top sail and hauled in weather at sunset the Cape bore distant 7 leagues Middle Part strong gales at 2 PM. Tacked ship to up N. W. Latter Part employed in ship duty saw 2 ships to the south. Log 110 - 00 W

Friday  
March 6  
1822  
First Part light breeze from the N. W. at 1 PM. Tacked in anchoring the fore top sail and hauled up the courses to land 2 leagues off Middle Part strong gales double reef the top sails Latter Part strong gales tacked off shore. Log

Saturday  
March 7  
1822  
First Part strong gales from the North West at 2 PM. Tacked in the fore and mizzen top sail saw 2 ships Middle Part strong gales Latter Part saw 2 ships to the fore and mizzen top sail. Log 22 - 00 W

Henry Cruising of Cape St Lucas

Sunday  
March 8  
1822  
First Part light breeze from the N. W. at 1 PM. Tacked ship to up N. W. the land 12 leagues off saw one ship Middle Part strong gales took in the fore & mainsail Latter Part tacked ship made all sail steering West. Log 22 - 00 W

Monday  
March 9  
1822  
First Part of this 24 hours strong winds from the N. W. steering West 11 miles all night Middle Part strong gales took in the light sails double reef the top sails Latter Part pleasant made all sail. Log 21 - 40 W

Tuesday  
March 10  
1822  
First Part pleasant breeze from the N. W. steering West at 1 PM. saw the Tres Marias bearing distant about 15 leagues Middle Part high wind Latter Part pleasant steering in shore Tres Marias lying in the Log 21 - 25 W  
Log 106 - 29 W

Wednesday  
March 11  
1822  
First Part pleasant breeze 2 boats went on shore for wood at sunset none of loaded Middle Part heaped on Latter Part pleasant 3 boats on shore after wood.
