

Remarks on Board Ship Charles
 Thursday March 12th 1875
 First Part pleasant breeze
 lie up and are employed in getting
 up wood Middle Part hauling
 Later Part 3 boats a shore for
 wood

Friday March 13th 1875
 First Part pleasant breeze in
 working Middle Part light breeze
 hauling wood enough for all
 Later Part pleasant breeze in
 stowing away wood saw the main
 land Lat 21-02 N
 Long

Saturday March 14th 1875
 First Part light breeze under all sail
 to up ship the cap's rope barientus
 bearing S by E distant 10 leagues
 passed a rock within 4 miles to the
 south of the ship Middle Part
 lie to with the main yard a back
 Later Part haul up S. M. employed
 Cape Corrientes in action of rapping
 Lt 20-32 N Rock 25 miles distant Lt 20-19 N
 Long 105-35 W Within the Cape Long 105-38 W

Sunday March 15th 1875
 First Part pleasant breeze
 from the north steering S by E
 employed in stowing away
 Middle Part strong gale under
 all sail Later Part strong
 winds steering ship S and a
 bump back Lat 18-59 N
 Long 105-18 W

Monday March 16th 1875
 Henry Bound for the Coast of Peru
 First Part strong trade from the
 NW by E lie up S by E and the
 main sail Middle Part equally
 took in the Jib & spanker at 9 A.M.
 then again Later Part fresh trade
 lie up S by E Lat 6-30 N
 Long

Tuesday March 17th 1875
 First Part at this 24 hours fresh trade
 from the NW by E lie up S by E employed in
 various jobs of ship duty
 Middle Part equally took in the main
 sail and set it again Later Part
 strong winds anchored the Jib to
 prevent Lat 5-45 N
 Long

Wednesday March 18th 1875
 First Part fresh trade from the
 NW by E lie up S by E at 4 P.M. bent
 the Jib and broke out the main hall
 for water Middle Part attend
 ed with squalls of rain
 Later Part the red trades made
 some sail Lat 05-00 N
 Long 97-52 W

Thursday March 19th 1875
 First Part light breeze attended with
 rain and the fore top gallant sail
 employed in ship's duty
 Middle Part equally lie up S by E
 Later Part hauling and raising
 under all sail employed in ship
 duty Lat 4-13 N
 Long
