Friday June 28th 1855
First Part strong trade from the S.W. hauled on board the fore top sail in
bent another saw one ship.
Middle Part strong trade to up
S. Latter Part strong gales on board
the main sail to mend

Saturday June 29th 1855
First Part strong gales from the S.W. hauled on board the main
sail at sunset wind S.W. hauled
Middle Part strong wind to up S.
Latter Part strong gales on board
in mending the main sail
Lat 5-4 S
Long

Sunday June 30th 1855
First Part strong trade from the
S.W. hauled at 2 PM bent the main
sail at 4 double reefed the top sail
at 6 reversed ship hauled the main
sail Middle Part strong
gales hauled on board Latter Part
made some sail hauled on board
saw one ship. Lat 5-25 S
Long

Monday June 29th 1855
First Part strong gales from
the S.W. hauled at sunset
shortened sail Middle Part
strong trade Latter Part
saw a large whale however
but did not catch him
Lat 4-30 S

the S.W. hauled on board in men
shing the fore top mast stay sail
at sunset took in the main sail
Middle Part strong trade took
ship hauled on board Latter Part made

Wednesday July 1st 1855
First Part strong trade hauled
on board in ships duty at sun
set took in the main sail
Middle Part strong trade took
ship hauled on board Latter Part made
sail on board in mending the
fore top sail saw one ship
Lat 5-18 S
Long

Thursday July 2nd 1855
First Part at this 24 hours from me
after compass in breaking out
for breezy and water
Middle Part light breeze
Latter Part saw a large whale
however but did not catch him
Lat 4-25 S
Long

Friday July 3rd 1855
First Part light breeze from the
S.W. hauled at sunset took in
the light sail took a bit hauled
Middle Part light breeze
Latter Part strong trade hauled
on board made some sail
Lat 4-27 S
Long
