

Remarks on Board Ship Charles

Sunday ^{13th} First Part of the 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the E. S. E. wind at 6 PM the trade was fair and Middle Part squalls hi up N. E. Latter Part strong gales and clear weather. Lat 4-24 S Long 157

Monday ^{14th} First strong trade hi up N. E. nothing in ship up note occurred at sunset trade ship to up S. E. Middle Part strong gales hi up S. Latter Part employed in cooping in the oil for stowing down. Lat 5-07 S Long 157

Tuesday ^{15th} First Part strong trade from the E. S. E. hi up S employed in breaking out the pore hatch at sunset trade ship hi up N. E. Middle Part strong trade Latter Part employed in stowing down in the pore hatch. Lat 4-50 S Long 106-00 W

Wednesday ^{16th} First Part strong trade and clear weather hi up N. E. hi up S employed in stowing down trade ship hi up S. Middle Part pleasant Latter Part made sail hi up S saw a ship to seaward. Lat 5-12 S Long 157

St. Henry being at Cross Island

Monday ^{24th} First Part light breeze from the S. E. steering W. N. E. all sail at sunset hauled up shore hi up N. E. It took in the top mast steering sail Middle Part hatching hi up S. Latter Part light breeze at 8 PM 3 boats went on shore for water the ship being up and on attended with rain.

Tuesday ^{25th} First Part at 2 PM the boats came overboard with the water touch in the water all sail for the fore hour the wind at 4 PM came to anchor in Chatham Bay in 12 fathoms water employed in getting wash ready for water. Middle Part water Latter Part all hands employed in getting up water and blacking the ships benches.

Wednesday ^{26th} First Part pleasant employed in emptying getting and stowing away water Middle Part rain Latter Part employed in watering and stowing away saw a brig off the harbour.

Thursday ^{27th} First Part rainy weather employed in stowing away water at 3 PM caught a Dimen fish and struck 3 more the one caught measured 12 feet in length 16 in breadth Middle Part rain Latter Part employed in getting up wood. Lat 5-00 S Long 157
