 Friday Aug 28 1851
 First Part light airs and rain
 at 1 PM weighed anchor for sea
 made all sail with a light breeze from
 the S. steering S.W. by E. and made
 the anchors at 4 PM hauled up E.
 Middle Part rain ship S.E.
 Latter Part much the same under
 the sails Lt 5 - 00 W
 Lt 86 - 10 W

Saturday Aug 29 1851
 First Part strong winds and rain
 weather from the S ship S.E.
 took in the fore top gallant sail.
 Middle Part squally ship S.E.
 Latter Part pleasant air bent the
 fore top gallant sail and bent a
 new one likewise the mizen top gal-
 lant sail to mend Lt 4 - 29 W
 Lt 85 - 04 W

Sunday Aug 30 1851
 First Part light breezes from the
 S ship S.E. finished mending the
 mizen top gallant sail and bent it.
 Middle Part light winds ship S.E.
 Latter Part pleasant under all
 sail ship S.E. Lt 3 - 28 S
 Lt 84

Monday Aug 31 1851
 First Part light airs and hailing
 from the S ship S.W. and S.W.
 Middle Part light breezes from
 the S.W. ship S.W. by E.
 Latter Part heavy gales ship
 S.W. Lt 2 - 23 W
 Lt 82 - 27 W

Henry Broun to Santa Sep 1851
 First Part of the 24 hours light breeze
 pleasant weather from the S ship
 Lt 9 - 00
 Middle Part tack ship ship S.W. by E.
 Latter Part light airs tack ship S.W.
 on bent the main top gallant sail to
 alter it Lt 05 - 14 S
 Lt 86

Tuesday Sep 2 1851
 First Part light airs from the S ship
 Lt 10 - 00
 Middle Part tack ship ship S.W. by E.
 Latter Part light breezes from the S ship
 Lt 03 - 06 S
 Lt 86

Wednesday Sep 3 1851
 First Part took a strong breeze from
 the S ship S.E. at 2 PM tack ship
 ship S.W. at 3 spoke the Rossseau
