 under Close reef top Sails fresh gale  
 Men employed at Ships Duty. So ends  
 this day
- Sept 11 Sunday this day finished Boiling Wind N.E.  
 fresh gale Bark under Close reef top S  
 Sails under Storm Sails Men employed at  
 Ships Duty. So ends this day
- Sept 12 Monday this day Wind N.E. Still blowing  
 a fresh gale buried the remains of  
 the Knaked a Native of the S Islands  
 who died very suddenly had been sick but  
 four days Men employed at Ships  
 Duty. So ends this day
- Sept 13 Tuesday this day Wind N.E. Bark under Close  
 reef Sails Cruising of Sea Horse Island  
 saw several Whales going quick Men  
 employed at Ships Duty. So ends this  
 day
- Sept 14 Wednesday this day Wind S. Gale Squalls  
 saw a Whale covered without success  
 latter part of the day whole top Sails  
 set Men employed at Ships Duty. So  
 ends this day
- Sept 15 Thursday this day this day Wind N.E. saw  
 the Sea Horse Island Dist 12 miles  
 Men employed at Ships Duty. So ends  
 this day
- Sept 16 Friday this day Wind N.E. saw Squalls working  
 saw Men employed at Ships Duty. So ends this day
