Sunday Sept 27th

Still hands employed in mending papers and books wind N.E. steering S.E.

Monday Sept 28th

Still hands employed in ships duty we saw a sail on the starboard bow and one on the starboard quarter and at 5 P.M. saw a ship on our larboard quarter steering N. by W. wind E. by S.

So ended these last 24 hours

Tuesday Sept 29th

Still hands employed in ship duty and we saw 4 sails we was steering S. wind N.E.

So ended these last 24 hours

Wednesday Sept 30th

Still hands employed in ships duty steering S. wind N.E. So ended these last 24 hours

Thursday Oct 1st

Still hands employed in ships duty we saw two sails about 5 P.M. the H. Berley raised a sperm whale on our lee beam and the S.B. and W.B. carried away and the S.B. went on and struck and got him turned up and along side about 7 P.M. steering S.E. wind N.E. 

So ended these 24 hours

Friday Oct 2nd

Still hands employed in rearing cutting gear and breaking out the blubber room and we commenced steering S. by W. wind N.E. by E.

So ended these 24 hours

Saturday Oct 3rd

Still hands employed in cutting in we saw a sail on our lee bow about sundown wind N.E. steering S.E. So ended these last 24 hours

Sunday Oct 4th

Still hands employed in the case and clearing away the head wind N.E. So ended these last 24 hours

Monday Oct 5th

Still hands employed in boiling out and clearing away the head wind N.E.

So ended these last 24 hours

Tuesday Oct 6th

Still hands still employed in boiling out we raised breakers on our lee bow finished boiling out about 4 in the afternoon the whale stowed down 75 lbs steering S.E.

So ended these last 24 hours

Wednesday Oct 7th

Still hands employed in cooping oil and breaking out the after hole and made land on our lee bow steering N.E.

So ended these last 24 hours

Thursday Oct 8th

we made the Island of Brava, saw two sail on our lee of the land run down to St. Paul got up chains and got ready to anchor to send home our oil but we had no opportunity being a board more sail and stood S.E.

So ended these last 24 hours
