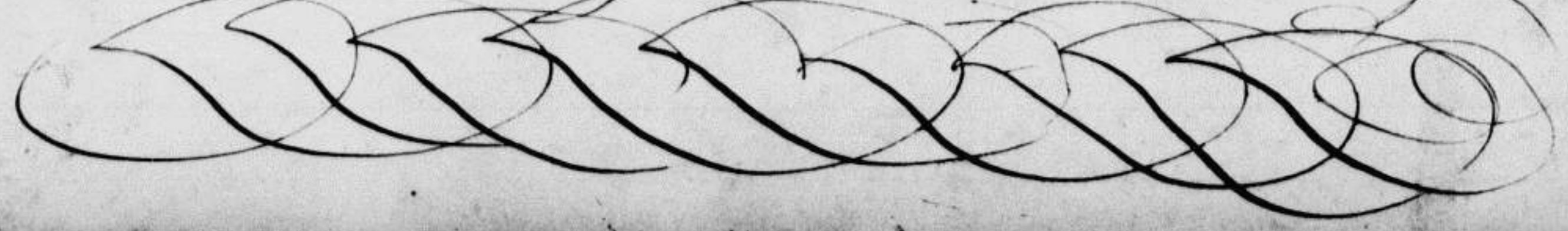
Thursday Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>

 The employed in ship duty raised a sail on the starboard bow standing S. E. wind N. W. So ends these last 24 hours

Sunday Nov. 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a sail on the starboard beam and one on the starboard quarter wind E by S steering on the wind So ends these last 24 hours

Monday Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a school of fin backs steering S. E. by E. wind N. W. So ends these last 24 hours



Tuesday Nov. 24<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty took in the fore main and mizen top gallant sails and the fore and mizen top sails and doubled reefed the main top sail steering S. by E. wind N. W. Lat. 33. 34. Long. 55 W. So ends these last 24 hours

Wednesday Nov. 25<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a sail on the lee bow steering on the wind wind E. So ends these last 24 hours

Thursday Nov. 26<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty setting up the fore rigging raised a sail on the lee beam raised fin backs So ends these 24 hours

Friday Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty setting up rigging raised a sail gam of right whales steering S. by E. wind N. W.

Saturday Nov. 28<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a sail two points on the starboard bow steering S. E. wind N. W. So ends these last 24 hours

Sunday Nov. 29<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a sail on the weather bow raised a fin back also right whales on the lee beam wind N. W. steering S. E. by E. So ends these last 24 hours

Monday Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>  
 The watch employed in ship duty raised a sail on point on the starboard bow spoke the ship. Herbernia of New Bedford 4 month out 40 lbs of Oil 20 lbs of sperm they lost one man by a whale steering S. E. by E. So ends these last 24 hours
