

The Ship Charles-Drew of Prov-Bedford

Sunday Jan the 30th 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a strong breeze from
the S.E. steering S.E. middle and
latter part at 1 wore ship to the Southward
steering by the wind S.W. by E. at 5 A.M. made
all sail with fine weather.

Lat 6° 39' N. Long.

Monday Jan the 31st 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a strong breeze from
the S.E. at 3 A.M. shortened some sail
middle and latter part fine breeze at 5
A.M. made all sail at 9 course was S.
with light squalls of rain at 11 shortened
sail.

Lat 5° 03' N Long. 134° 26'

Tuesday Feb the 1st 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a strong breeze from
the E. steering S. at sunset shortened
sail and wore ship to the Eastward
with squally weather middle and latter
part strong breeze at 5 A.M. set the topsails
at 9 reefed them steering W. by N.

Wednesday Feb the 2nd 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a strong breeze and
squally weather steering W. by N. at
sunset shortened some sail. middle and
latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. tacked
the reef out of the topsails steering W. by N.
with fine weather.

Lat 6° 16' Long. 138° 56'

Thursday Feb the 3rd 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a moderate breeze
from the S.E. steering S. with fine
weather at sunset took in sail and
luffed to the wind heading E. middle
and latter part fine weather at 5 A.M.
made all sail steering by the wind
to the Eastward at 4 reefed off to W. by N.

Lat 6° 18' N Long. "

Friday Feb the 4th 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a fine breeze from
the S.E. steering W. by N. at 2 A.M. luffed
to the wind heading S. at sunset took
in sail middle and latter part strong
breeze at 5 A.M. wore ship to the Eastward
and made all sail steering by the wind
to the Northward.

Lat 6° 16' Long. "

Saturday Feb the 5th 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a fine breeze from the
S.E. steering S. by the wind middle and
latter part pleasant steering by the wind
S.

Lat 4° 28' N Long. "

Sunday Feb the 6th 1848

These 24 hours
commenced with a fine breeze from
the S.E. steering S. with pleasant
weather at 11 A.M. made all sail at sunset
shortened sail middle and latter part
strong breeze and pleasant weather.

Lat 2° 25' N Long. "
