Monday Feb the 14th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a light breeze from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part moderate weather at 5 P.M. made all sail steering S.E. at 8 o'clock ship to the Southward steering S.E. at 9 o'clock the fore topsail set

Tuesday Feb the 15th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze from the Eastward steering by the wind S.E. at 4 P.M. bent the fore topsail set at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part pleasant weather at 5 P.M. made sail steering S.E. at 8 o'clock the fore topsail to wear

Lat 15. N. Long 138.15

Wednesday Feb the 16th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward steering S.E. with fine weather at sunset took in sail at 4 P.M. began to boil the blackfish middle and latter part pleasant weather at 5 P.M. made all sail steering S. at 9 o'clock off S.W.

Thursday Feb the 17th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward steering S.E. at 4 P.M. bent the fore topsail at sunset shortened sail

middle and latter part fine weather at 5 P.M. made all sail at 8 o'clock the main topsail steering by the wind S.E. Lat " " Long " "

Friday Feb the 18th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward steering S.E. at sunset shortened sail middle and latter part fine weather at 5 P.M. made all sail steering S.W. by S. Lat " " Long 138.25

Saturday Feb the 19th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze from the Eastward steering S.W. at sunset shortened sail and luffed to the wind S.E. with light squalls of rain middle and latter part fine weather at 5 P.M. made all sail

Lat 1.16 S. Long " "

Sunday Feb the 20th 1848

These 24 hours commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward steering S.W. middle and latter part moderate breeze at 5 P.M. set the mainsail steering S.W. by W. Lat " " Long " "

Monday Feb the 21st 1848

These 24 hours commences with a moderate breeze from the Eastward steering S.W. by W. middle
