

The Ship Charles-Drew of New Bedford

The South. and made moderate at 4 AM
made sail and wore ship S.W. at 10
still saw the land of the North-West coast
distant about 50 miles

These 24 hours
commences with a light breeze from
the S.W. steering N.E. at 5 AM. saw
right whales and lowered 3 boats and
chased but did not get on at sunset sunset
took in sail with whale in sight middle
and latter part strong breeze at 8 AM.
shortened sail

Thursday Apr. the 13th 1845

These 24 hours
commences with a moderate gale from
the E.S.E. veering to the Southward under
close reefed main topsail middle and
latter part light breeze at 4 AM made
all sail at 6 wore ship to N.E.

Friday Apr. the 14th 1845

These 24 hours
commences with calm and cloudy weather
steering N.E. at 4 AM a light breeze from
the Westward at sunset took in sail heading
N.E. by E. middle and latter part light breeze
and light squalls of snow

Saturday Apr. the 15th 1845

These 24 hours commences
with a fine breeze from the Westward
steering N.E. at sunset took in sail heading
N.E. by N. with squalls of snow middle part
moderate latter part strong breeze at 5 AM made
sail and saw right whales but did not lower
after them

Sunday Apr. the 16th 1845

These 24 hours
commences with a strong breeze from
the W.S.W. steering N.E. under double
reefed topsails at 6 AM. took in sail and heaved
to the wind to the Northward middle and
latter part a gale from the N.W. heading
N.E.

Monday Apr. the 17th 1845

These 24 hours commences
with a moderate gale from the N.W. heading
N.E. middle and latter part more moderate
at 5 AM made short sail at 10 made all sail
heading to the Northward

Tuesday Apr. the 18th 1845

These 24 hours
commences with a moderate breeze from
the Westward steering by the wind N. at
sunset took in sail heading N.E. middle
and latter part fine breeze with clear weather
at 2 AM made sail steering to the Southward
