Sunday June the 11th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with light air and
calm steering to the Eastward at
1 P.M. lowered for a whale and saw
nothing at 4 P.M. had a breeze from the
E.S.E. steering to middle and latter part
light breeze and foggy weather at 10 P.M.
made short sail

Monday June the 12th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with a light breeze from
the S.E. steering to the Eastward
with fog at 3 P.M. saw a right whale
and lowered 4 boats and chased it was
all in vain at 4 saw him again and
lowered 4 boats and got fast and killed
and he sunk with one ship in
sight at 8 P.M. took in sail middle and
latter part moderate weather with 2
ships in sight at 11 P.M. spoke the
ship Emily Morgan

Tuesday June the 13th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with a moderate breeze from
the S.E. heading to the Eastward with
cloudy weather in company with the

Capt. Coffin on the North West Coast.

Emily Morgan at 8 P.M. backed ship to
the Westward middle and latter part
steering breeze with rain and fog
steering S.E. by E.

Wednesday June the 14th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with a strong breeze from
the E.S.E. steering S.E. by E. with
rain and fog at 12 P.M. wore ship to
S.E. thick and rainy at 4 P.M. took
in sail middle and latter part light
air and calm at 6 set whole topsails

Thursday June the 15th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with a calm and fog steering
S. at 2 P.M. a light breeze from the East-
ward steering to the Southward at 4
P.M. wind in thick and rainy at 7 P.M.
shortened sail middle and latter part
a gale from the Eastward at 9 P.M. wore
ship to S.E.

Friday June the 16th 1848

These 24 hours
commences with a gale from the Eastward
heading E. with fog and rain at 5 P.M.
wore ship to S.E. at sunset moderate
middle and latter part strong breeze with
fog and rain at 10 P.M. set the fore and mizzen
topsails heading S.E.
