

Tuesday Aug. the 8th 1848

Come with a fresh breeze from the Southth and Westth stowing down Oil at 4th lowered 1 boat and chased but no success at 5 finished stowing down and lowered 3 boats and chased but no success 2 ships in sight rainy weather middle part fresh breeze latter part at 8 commenced stowing down Oil with rainy weather still a boiling

Wednesday Aug. the 9th 1848

Come with a strong breeze from the Southth and Westth with rain at 5 finished stowing down right whale in sight middle part at 5 lowered one boat and chased but no success latter part strong breeze at 8 lowered 3 boats with plenty of whales in sight got fast to one and he went off with one line we killed one and he sank and took 2 lines we were a boiling

Thursday Aug. the 10th 1848

Come with a moderate breeze from the Southth and Westth with plenty of whales at 3 lowered 3 boats and struck but the iron drew middle and latter part light breeze at 4th lowered 3 boats and got one whale at boiling with one ship in sight

Friday Aug. the 11th 1848

These 24 hours Come with a light breeze from the Southth and Westward at 4 took the whale along side and took in part of him middle part a boiling with rain latter part some cutting the rest of him with one ship

Saturday Aug. the 12th 1848

Come with a light breeze from the Southth and Westth a cutting with one ship in sight at 3th finished cutting latter middle and latter part foggy weather at 7th commenced stowing down Oil still a boiling

Sunday Aug. the 13th 1848

Come with a moderate breeze from the Southth and Westth with fog stowing down Oil latter part middle part at 5 finished stow stowing down latter part fresh breeze still a boiling

Monday Aug. the 14th 1848

Come with a strong breeze from the Southth and Westth steering to the Westth middle and latter part fine breeze from the Southth and Eastth steering to the Westth still a boiling

Tuesday Aug. the 15th 1848

Come with a strong breeze from the Southth and Eastth steering S. W. by W. with fog and rain at 7 were ship to S. E. by E. middle and latter part a gale from the Southth at 7th commenced stowing down Oil still a boiling with fog and rain

Wednesday Aug. the 16th 1848

Come with a strong breeze from the Southth heading
