

Ship Charles Drew from the

Saturday Oct 10th 1846

Came in with moderate trades by the wind to the S. employed stowing the Oil between decks at 3 P.M. took a heavy squall put the Ship before the wind & clinched up & down all the sails. Wind pleasant. Latter had another squall but did not carry anything away on any account. Single reefs. The top washed ship to 13.4

Sunday Oct 11th

Came with light winds E & S. by the wind. S. at sail. Saw a large break in the air. Not a certain what it was. The Parish hills afflicted with bile & a little wind. All much the same. Latter light squalls of rain. Lat 11.34 Long 17.30

Monday Oct 12th

Came with light variable winds & calm passing showers rain. All much the same. Latter light winds S. & W. & pleasant course. S. by S. employed various ways. Lat 10.36

Tuesday Oct 13th

Light breeze S. & W. course. S. by S. saw a sail broke out for water. Opened a cask bread, flour & Malt & Latter about the same employed mending boat. Blacksmithing coopering. S. & W. ship to 10.32 20.32

Wednesday Oct 14

Came light breeze S. & W. & showers of rain. Course S. by S. will rainy. Latter wind S. & W. employed various ways. Lat 9.32 Long 19.30

Thursday Oct 15

First part light winds from S. W. to S. & showers of rain. S. by S. a squall. Wind squally. Doubt reefs. The top. Latter fine weather. Wind S. by S. the match employed various ways. Capt & Carpenter mending the S. ship. Lat 8.12 Long 18.5

Friday Oct 16

Light rain & calm light showers of rain. Wind S. by S. Latter about the same. Course S. by S. wind S. by S. Lat 7.7 Long 17.39

Saturday Oct 17

Came with light winds from S. to S. W. course. S. by S. saw a shoal of Blackfish. Wind & Latter wind about the same & rainy washed ship. Lat 6.1

Cape Verde Island Towards the Line

Sunday Oct 18th 1846

First part light winds from S. to S. W. & steady rain. Course S. by S. Wind & Latter much the same. at 9 A.M. tacked to the N. at 11 tacked again to the S. (No Obs.)

Monday Oct 19th

Moderate breeze S. & raining. By the wind S. by S. Wind much the same. Latter wind S. to S. W. tacked to the S. saw a sail off the weather line. Spiced a barrel Beef. Lat 4.32 Long 17.30

Tuesday Oct 20th

Came with a fine breeze from S. to S. W. filled two pipes in the storage for water. Latter at sunset tacked to the E. Wind much the same. at 1.30 tacked to the E.

at daylight tacked to the N. again. Latter about the same. filled the boats with water. Lat 4.10 17.15

Wednesday Oct 21st

Came in about the same. Wind & Latter light rain. all smooth & rainy. No Obs.

Thursday Oct 22nd

Light and all round the compass & rainy. Wind & Latter much the same. several sail in sight. the match making. sunset scurrying by. Lat 3.10 Long 16.40

Friday Oct 23rd

Came with light wind S. & light squalls of rain. by the wind S. by S. Wind & Latter fine breeze S. steering by the

wind S. by S. The Capt. filled the latter & commenced turning. being the other employed various ways. a long off the quarter. Lat 2.20 Long 15.20

Saturday Oct 24th

Came with a fine breeze S. by the wind S. by S. the big to land & a sail astern. Wind & Latter with trades S. to S. W. steering by the wind S. by S. employed making rope for topmasts. Lat 1.20 14.30

Sunday Oct 25th

Came about the same. pointed the S. B. at the Wind & Latter strong trades S. by S. by the wind S. by S. Lat 1.24 14.35
