

Ship Charles Drown in the Indian Ocean
Sunday Dec. 13th 1846

Came with strong gales N.W. & cloudy course
S.E. the Bark in sight saw a finch Mid & Latten
a little more moderate Lat 39 41

Monday Dec. 14th
Came with fresh gales N.W. & cloudy course S.E. by E the
Bark still in sight Mid & Latten some fog saw a
finch Lat 37 40 Long 39 52

Tuesday Dec. 15th
Came with a fine breeze N.W. & cloudy course S.E. by E
saw many finches Mid much the same Latten shiny
3 sail in sight No Abz

Wednesday Dec. 16th

Came with fresh gales N.W. & raining a 5 took in the
light sails & double reefed the top at 7 the same N.W.
Mid much the same Latten wind S.W. & set main top
gall sail course S.E. by E one sail in sight Lat 40 40

Thursday Dec. 17th

First part more moderate made all sail wind S.W. course
S.E. by E Mid & Latten much the same Lat 40 39
fine calm broad

Friday Dec. 18th

Came with a light breeze S.W. & cloudy by the wind
S.E. by E Mid & Latten as same finches Lat 41 21 Long 30 25

Saturday Dec. 19th

First part light variable winds & squalls of fog
opened a barrel Pump Mid & Latten about the same
filled the butts with water Lat 42 11 Long 34 50

Sunday Dec. 20th
Came with a moderate breeze N.W. & cloudy course S.E. by E
caught a porpoise. Wind wind shifted to the N.W.
it rained Latten do double reefed the Lt. May. top.
Monday Dec. 21st

Came in with strong gales N.W. at 3 P.M. cleared up
& the sun came out course S.E. by E Mid & Latten
were sent to N. & N.W. & moderated some made
all sail set & saw a finch Lat 43 58 Long 39 50

Tuesday Dec. 23rd 1846

Begins with a fresh breeze N.W. & steering E.
opened a barrel pump Mid some squalls took in
Lt. May. top gall sails & fly jib Latten about the same
some rain No Abz

Wednesday Dec. 23rd

First part strong gales N.W. & raining took in the
Lt. May. top gall sail at 3 set it again steering E. Mid
& Latten from neither all sail out but new fore
topmast staysail & ripped up the old one
Lat 41 10 Long 37 12

Thursday Dec. 24th

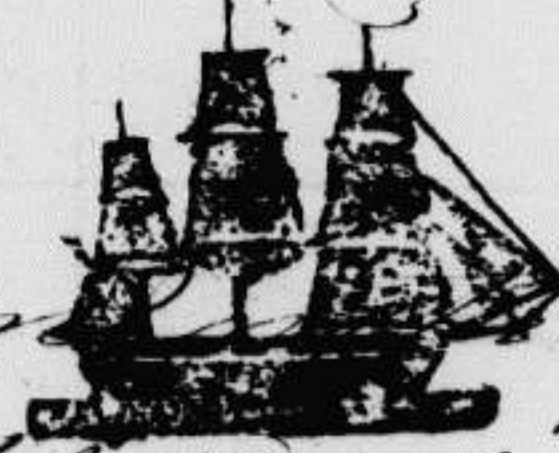
Came with a moderate breeze from the N.W. & course
E by N. saw a shoal of blackfish and not put off for
them Mid & Latten about the same Lat 39 40 Long 40 30

Friday Dec. 25th

Came with a fresh breeze N.W. & cloudy course E by S
Mid strong gales N.W. took in top gall sails Latten
about the same Lat 30 45 Long 44 01

Saturday Dec. 26th

Came with fresh gales N.W. & cloudy course E by E at 6 P.M.
set top gall sails & mainsail saw a whale spout
Mid & Latten about the same at 11 A.M. made the Pt.
of St. Paul bearing S.E. by E dist 20 M. saw finches



Sunday Dec. 27th

Came with fresh gales N.W. at 2 P.M. the
Capt. & 3 mates & 2 boats crews went on fish-
ing spoke the Ship Silver of Boston for Batavia
saw the Bark Washington of Greenport 5 or 6 M.
Whale lit at 7 the boats returned & we proceeded
on our intended voyage course E by E Mid & Latten
more moderate spoke the Tr of Greenport

Monday Dec. 28th

Light wind N.W. & cloudy all sail set course S.E. by E
Mid & Latten fresh gales N.W. & saw a finch
opened a barrel Pump Lat 39 12
