 Moderate gales S & W Sunday Jan. 30th 1847
 + some rain. double reefed the tops
 cruising for sperm whale, broached a 90 molf. Mid light in
 + foggy. Latter light wind from S & W took S & W + thick
 atmosphere steering by the wind S & W Lat 44 46 1753

Monday Feb. 1st
 Fine breeze S & W + heavy all sail set steering by
 the wind S & W at sunset took in sail + more ship
 to the S. + set quarter masted mill + Latter fresh breeze
 S & W + overcast ship heading S & W at 10th saw the Chatham
 bearing S & W by 15th M. also a sail

Tuesday Feb. 2nd
 Comd with fresh gales S steering by the wind
 E & S at sunset took in sail Mid about the
 same Latter wind the same with signals of fog. Sea fresh
 Lat 45 49 176

Wednesday Feb. 3rd
 Comd with light winds S & E + pleasant spoke the Bark
 Harvest of Warren & S. the Capt. went on board at 2
 returned & took in sail Mid + Latter the same opened
 6th Reef + took in Flour Lat 45 23

Thursday Feb. 4th
 Comd with light winds E + fine weather at sunset took
 in sail Mid much the same Latter cloudy Lat 45 14 Long 175

Friday Feb. 5th
 Light winds E & S + overcast all sail set steering by
 S & W at sunset took in sail Mid + Latter nearly
 same Lat 45 4 Long 176

Saturday Feb. 6th
 Moderate breeze S & E + cloudy. Conceded the boat for
 black fish but did not get fast Ship by the wind
 E. Mid double reefed the 1st Mizzen top + some rain Latter
 wind shifted to the S & W + raining steering E & S. No 6th

Sunday Feb. 7th
 More gales S & W close reefed 1st + Main top +
 hauled the Mizzen steering E & S Mid + Latter more
 the same with signals of hail + rain
 Lat 45 27



Ship Charles Brown in the South Pacific
 Monday Feb. 8th 1847
 First part wind S & W but more moderate set top
 gale sail course S & E by E Mid wind carried to that
 the Latter about the same Lat 44 21

Tuesday Feb. 9th
 Moderate gales S course S & E Mid + Latter light wind
 S & W. watch employed various ways Lat 43 11

Wednesday Feb. 10th
 Light wind S & W + calm the watch making mts
 objects & Mid no Latter fresh gales S & E. by the
 wind E repaired the fly jib + bent it No 6th

Thursday Feb. 11th
 Comd with fresh gales S & S & cloudy ship
 by the wind E. Mid + Latter thick + rainy
 employed making gaskets &c. No 6th

Friday Feb. 12th
 Comes in with fresh gales S & S & W + rainy at
 8 double reefed the tops Mid much the same Latter
 thick fog wind S & W opened both broad a 6th Reef
 started water &c. Lat 43 43 Long 156 2

Saturday Feb. 13th
 First part light winds S & S & W + the weather more
 clear all sail set steering S & by E. Mid + Latter
 moderate breeze S & W Lat 40 24

Sunday Feb. 14th
 Comd with light winds S & W + fine weather
 all drawing sail set steering S. Mid about the same
 Latter light breeze S & W Lat 39 5

Monday Feb. 15th
 Comes in with a light breeze S & W + very pleasant
 all sail out steering S. Mid + Latter light variable
 winds + good weather repaired the M. top Lat 38 5 153 53

Tuesday Feb. 16th
 Last part light winds from the E. unbent the
 new top at the Main sent up another Mid + Latter
 about the same Lat 36 11
