

Ship Charles Drown from Norway for the coast

Monday April 12th 1847

First part more moderate but a heavy swell from S.E. steering by the wind S.W. saw a shoal of blackfish at 5 P.M. set S.W. topgall sail. Mid light and calm. Letter light mended from the dock in S. Boat to repair painted the Boat. bent new close Mizen &c

Lat 27 46 163 15

Tuesday April 13th

Fresh gales S.W. & S.W. course at by the painted S. Boat at 8 o'clock with rain here her two heads to the S. Mid or Letter set could reef top, mizen S.W. opened a barrel beef & pork painted the Boat &c

Wednesday April 14th

Fresh gales S.W. & clear weather ship under would reef top, headed to the S. Mid & Letter more moderate mizen de sail painted the Boat &c

Lat 27 49

Thursday April 15th

Moderate breeze S.W. & a little rain course at S.W. sent down Miz topgall sail & jibs. Mid wind came out S.W. & strong double reefed the top. Letter mizen about the same & cloudy mending sails bent the Old main sail

Lat 32 7

Friday April 16th

Fresh gales S.W. & cloudy, steering by the wind S.W. Mid some rain Letter cloudy, opened cask ton line mizen mast coat for the Miz mast. broached barrel flour

Lat 33 49 160 35

Saturday April 17th

Light mizen S.W. & cloudy, mid about the same Letter a little rain & foggy mizen a cutting stage &c. Lat 34 42 160 39

Sunday April 18th

First part wind calmed to S. & clear weather steered to the S.W. mid about the same Letter light breeze S.W. & clear S.W. & E. great many porpoise many of 1000 in sight

Lat 34 55

Monday April 19th

Came with a light breeze S.W. & fine weather by the wind S.W. Mid & Letter as some fog sent down the S. top to repair & bent the stow

Lat 36 17

Tuesday April 20th

First part light and calm, reefing top &c. course at S.W. Mid fresh breeze S.W. Letter blowing on with some rain close reefed two top, headed jib & mizen bent out for water opened all Beef &c

Wednesday April 21st 1847

Blowing fresh & heavy swell from W. ship under close reefed topsails headed to the S.W. Mid & Letter about the same

Thursday April 22nd

Came in about the same with a little rain saw a shoal of blackfish Mid & Letter mizen S.W. & rainy course at S.W. 4 min on the deck list. No Ob.

Lat 37 57

Friday April 23rd

Fresh gales S.W. & rainy, mid & Letter S.W. with passing squales of hail & rain split the S. top

Lat 42 49 161 3

Saturday April 24th

Fresh gales S.W. & squally at 5 P.M. close reefed the top & headed the jib & mizen sail headed to the S.W. Mid & Letter about the same

Lat 43 44

Sunday April 25th

First part more moderate set whole top at 7 P.M. fresh gales S.W. & angry rain double reefed the top course S.W. by S.W. Mid & Letter much the same saw finches

Lat 45 28

Monday April 26th

Fresh gales & squally heavy swell by the wind S.W. to S. Mid & Letter more moderate & some rain

Lat 47 17

Tuesday April 27th

Light mizen from W. to S.W. by the wind to the S. opened all Beef & pork cask bread at 4, tacked to the W. Will do Letter mizen S.W. & some snow at 8 S.W. put off 3 boats for a wright whale did not get fast cooping (Medit &c)

Lat 48 3

Wednesday April 28th

Fresh gales & a bad sea S.W. struck a whale got foul line & cut at sunset took in sail headed to the S.W. Mid light mizen Letter fresh breeze & cloudy, finished cooping meat &c

Thursday April 29th

Fresh gales & ruffled put off 3 boats did not get fast light showers rain at sunset took in sail Mid blow strong & rainy Letter much the same saw a Sulphur bottom mizen S.W.
