

Ship Charles Drew N.W. Coast

Saturday Aug 21<sup>st</sup> 1847

Fresh gales S.W. & clear weather steering E & E for  
whales finished stowing the oil 63 bbls Mid & Latten about  
the same saw many finned red hals &c. Lat 53 45 134.7

Sunday Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>

Fresh gales & cloudy S.W. steering by the wind to the S  
& E beat the S top at the main at 3 P.M. saw the ship  
Queen Charlotte's Isle bearing N.E. 25 miles at 6 o'clock to  
the S.W. at sunset double reefed the top Mid & Latten  
fresh gales S.W. double reefed top to the S.W. Lat 53 42



Monday Aug 23<sup>rd</sup>

Came in about the same spoke Ship Portsmouth of  
Haven N.E. Mid & Latten some fog Lat 53 36

Tuesday Aug 24<sup>th</sup>

First part fine breeze S.W. & some fog by the wind to the  
S.W. spoke Ship Galapagos N.E. 9 miles the sea Mid & Latten  
as steering to the W. opened bbl flour Lat 53 43

Wednesday Aug 25<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh gales S. & foggy down to the S.W. Mid wind  
N.E. Latten S.E. & foggy hauls by the wind to the S.W. 55 10

Thursday Aug 26<sup>th</sup>

Strong gales S.E. & a heavy swell by the wind to the S.W. Mid  
& Latten the same with fog double reefed the S.W. Mid & Latten  
Lat 53 10

Friday Aug 27<sup>th</sup>

Wind the same but more moderate & thick fog by the  
wind to the S.W. Mid & Latten much the same (sailing)

Saturday Aug 28<sup>th</sup>

Wind shifted to W. & stopped raining course E & S.E. opened  
bbl flour & fresh Mid & Latten fresh gales W. & S.W. & placed  
out course E & S.E. Latten none of board Lat 51 36

Sunday Aug 29<sup>th</sup> Long 144 40

Came the same Mid made Latten light air & calm  
Lat 50 22

Monday Aug 30<sup>th</sup>

First part light breeze from S. & S.W. steering E & S.E.  
In St. Francisco Mid & Latten foggy opened casks bread  
& dry butter

Tuesday Aug 31<sup>st</sup> 1847

First part light breeze S. & foggy spoke Ship Hann  
abal Sag Harbour & the sea Mid & Latten light breeze  
& fine weather repairing sails boats setting up shooks  
for water &c. Lat 47 51

Wednesday Sept 1<sup>st</sup>

Wind & weather the same & the water employed about  
& the same Mid & Latten light variable winds & fine  
weather chased blackfish but got none Lat 47 31

Thursday Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>

Light breeze from the S. by the wind E & S.E. Mid do  
Latten foggy chased blackfish started water &c. Lat 46 12 N

Friday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> Long 135 11 W

Produce breeze from the W. steering S.E. Mid & Latten  
much the same employed boat building &c. Lat 44 46

Saturday Sept 4<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze S.W. & fine weather course E & S.E. Mid  
fresh gales S. spoke fresh solution of S. York 5 days from  
St. Francisco for Columbia river Lat 43 47 131

Sunday Sept 5<sup>th</sup>

Fresh gales S. & W. course E & S.E. washed ship &c. at sunset  
at double reefed the top Mid gale increasing handed jib &  
mainsail Latten wind the same & regga Lat 41.4 128 18  
opened bbl beef

Monday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>

Came in the same course E by S at 7 1/2 hours here too to the  
N.E. Mid more moderate kept off again Latten blowing on  
shortened sail & here too again Lat 40.3 Long 126 30

Tuesday Sept 7<sup>th</sup>

Came in the same at 5 P.M. moderate made sail & there  
E & S Mid light air S & some fog Latten do washed ship  
&c. steering by the wind to the E at 10 A.M. made the land  
to the S of the port at 12 M. took off shore S.W. & S.

Wednesday Sept 8<sup>th</sup> No Ob

Came in with light breeze S.E. & heavy standing by the wind  
S.W. Mid light air & calm Latten calm & light washed ship  
outward Lat 39 10
