

Ship Charles Drew from San Francisco for Salango

Sunday Oct. 17th 1847

First part made breeze S.W. & a heavy swell from it at 4 some rain course E.S.E. mid & latter much the same
No Obs

Monday Oct. 18th

Came in with a fine breeze from the S & cloudy steering E.S.E. mid fresh gales I took in Stoppelt sheet & fly the latter much the same
Lat 4° 54' Long 75° 28'

Tuesday Oct. 19th

First part fresh gales S & overcast steering by the wind mid do latter wind from S.E. to S & cloudy No Obs

Wednesday Oct. 20

Fine breeze from the S & E by the wind from E to E.S.E. opened catch broad & bbl flour mid & latter about the same made a new runner for the 7th stop 3.21 91 15

Thursday Oct. 21st

Fresh breeze S & fine weather steering by the wind E.S.E. opened bbl flour mid & latter no repaired main hatch

Friday Oct. 22nd

Came in the same saw a fourth mid & latter
Lat 1.34

Saturday Oct. 23rd

Fine breeze from the S steering by the wind from E to E.S.E. mid heading S.W. by S latter the wind backing Lat 42° 86' 32"

Sunday Oct. 24

Fine breeze S steering by the wind E.S.E. mid & latter much the same & cloudy

Monday Oct. 25th

First part moderate breeze S & cloudy by the wind E.S.E. mid & latter much the same spoke Bark Lyons of N.Y. 26 Nov 750
Lat 18° 18' 24" 2nd Mr.

Tuesday Oct. 26th

Fine breeze S & cloudy by the wind E.S.E. mid & latter much the same

Wednesday Oct. 27th

Came in with a moderate breeze from S.W. S.W. & cloudy by the wind S.E. mid & latter do
Lat 134



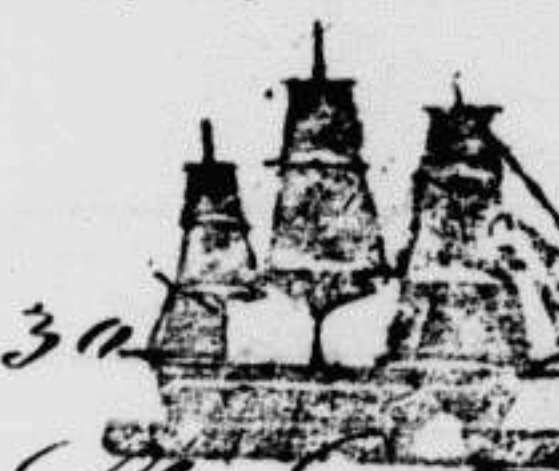
Ship Charles Drew off Salango

Thursday Oct. 28th 1847

First part light air from S.W. S.W. & pleasant steering by the wind E.S.E. to S.E. at 3 P.M. made the land bearing E.N.E. 20 M distant opened bbl. Beef & Pick. mid & latter wind from S to S.W. at 3 P.M. saw in 40 fathoms water tacked off shore at 4 tacked in again at 10 kept off for Salango
Lat 1.52

Friday Oct. 29th

Light breeze from S to S.W. & cloudy spoke Bark Rosewood of N. Bedford 15 M distant 9 M off shore hauled by the wind again to work up to Somers in co. with the B. saw 2 Bright Tria & latter some fog at Mer. St. Helena point low N.E. 25 M distant 3 sail in sight

Saturday Oct. 30th

Fresh breeze S.W. & cloudy by the wind from S.W. to S.E. at 4 P.M. spoke Spanish Brig Josephine & sold her 100 bbls bread at 13 1/2 q. opened catch bread mid do at daylight point - saw S.P.E. 15 M at 11 spoke ships Amethyst & Mary Trauer of N.B. at 13 1/2 came to anchor in fathoms

Sunday Oct. 31st

Fine breeze S.W. & match at the town on liberty at 4 P.M. returned



Monday Oct. 1st

Fine weather got off four boat loads wood & filled a raft of water

Tuesday Nov 3rd

Wind S.W. & fine weather got off 3 boat loads wood. Sailed Ship Emily Morgan

Wednesday Nov 3rd

Wind & weather the same towed raft water down to the point & got off 2 boat loads wood 10 bunches bananas & 11 pe. of fish

Thursday Nov 4th

Fine weather light breeze from S. got off 2 boat loads wood 17 catch water etc

Friday Nov 5th

Moderate breeze S.W. & fine weather got off 4 boat loads etc & took on board 110 bbls sweet potatoes

Saturday Nov 6th

Fine weather got off boat loads wood kept at the town took off 3 bbls Captain's table & 3 or 4 bbls crew found bbl Beef & pork
