

# Ship Charles Drew on the Line

Sunday Jan 9<sup>th</sup> 1848

First part moon traces & heavy swell put off 4 boats for blackfish did not get fast. Mia the same carried all sail through the night. Latter do

Lat 5<sup>th</sup> S Long 130.

Monday Jan 10<sup>th</sup>

Strong trades ESE & pleasant cruising for whales. Mia & Latter the same broached a boll blow. Lat 10<sup>th</sup> S

Tuesday Jan 11<sup>th</sup>

Comes in more moderate & fine weather, but no fish. Mia & Latter the same

Lat 00 Long 130 5

Wednesday Jan 12<sup>th</sup>

Moon traces ESE & fine weather put off for blackfish but saw there no more. Mia & Latter the same chased black fish carrying all sail night & day to help to unswear

Thursday Jan 13<sup>th</sup>

Light winds ESE & fine weather chased blackfish opened all sail. Mia & Latter the same

Lat 6<sup>th</sup> S

Friday Jan 14<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with <sup>light</sup> ESE & pleasant. chased many blackfish. Mia & Latter do

Saturday Jan 15<sup>th</sup>

Light trades ESE spoke ship Whorly at 10<sup>th</sup> Mia & Latter the same opened all sail

Sunday Jan 16<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with light breeze ESE & pleasant at 10<sup>th</sup> the Capt went on board the W. Mia & Latter about the same

Lat 1<sup>st</sup> S

Monday Jan 17<sup>th</sup>

Fresh trades ESE & pleasant standing to the S. Mia & Latter the same blacksmith making iron

Lat 1 43 Long 131 37

Tuesday Jan 18<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with fresh trades ESE & pleasant to the S. Mia & Latter the same spoke ship Emily Morgan at 10<sup>th</sup> Capt went on board standing to the S

Lat 1 46 Long 132 10

Wednesday Jan 19<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with moon traces ESE & fine weather in C. Mia & Latter do

Lat 1 11

Thursday Jan 20<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a fine breeze ESE & fine weather at 6 P. M. the Capt went on board the W. Mia & Latter much the same

Lat 30<sup>th</sup> S

# Ship Charles Drew on the Line

Friday Jan 21<sup>st</sup> 1848

First part light breeze from the E. & a light shower of rain blacksmith employed making whale irons the E Morgan in sight opened all sail & Latter fine weather steering S.W.

Lat 1 12 S

Saturday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup>

Moon traces & fine weather steering S.W. Mia do Latter steering S.W. I set up the main stay turned in the W topmast backstays &c.

Lat 40<sup>th</sup> S Long 132

Sunday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>

Moon traces ESE & fine weather steering S.W. Mia & Latter the same saw blackfish

Lat 1<sup>st</sup> S

Monday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

Light trades & fine weather steering off to the W. saw blackfish & porpoises going quick to wind. Mia & Latter the same watch fitting rigging

Lat 14<sup>th</sup> S

Tuesday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with a fine breeze ESE & pleasant steering S.W. Mia about the same Latter strong trades

Lat 21<sup>st</sup> S

Wednesday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with strong trades Mia & Latter the same watch employed, rattling, rigging &c.

Lat 1 56 S

Thursday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

First part strong trades ESE & pleasant steering by the wind to the S. Mia & Latter the same

Lat 3 34 Long 135 13

Friday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

More moderate still standing to the S. watch employed on the rigging Mia & Latter fresh breeze

Lat 5 25

Saturday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with fresh trades heading to the S. Mia & Latter all sail watch employed at 10<sup>th</sup> Mia & Latter do scraped & rammed the square & filed the butts

Lat 6 26
