

Ship Charles Drew bound to the I. S. Idles

Monday Feb 21st 1848

First part light winds E & E + fine weather steering by W. Mid & Latter do all hands employed lunch
Latter 1.00

Tuesday Feb 22nd

First part squalls of rain Mid & Latter fine weather broke out fine peak for shoek + after lots to make stowage
(all hands) Latter 3.14

Wednesday Feb 23rd

First breeze from the E steering at finished beaching put started all buff + Port. Mid do Latter showed of rain watch employed setting up shooks for water Latter 5.33
(brought all materials)

Thursday Feb 24th

First part moderate breeze from the E + squalls of rain steering at by W. Mid & Latter do Latter 7.24 Long 140.31

Friday Feb 25th

First part light variable winds + showers of rain course at W. Mid & Latter pleasant Latter 8.9 Long 140.25

Saturday Feb 26th

First part light winds E & E + pleasant chasing blackfish with truck one + then Mid & Latter toward center at E watch employed staving rigging &c. Latter 9.01

Sunday Feb 27th

Came in with a moderate breeze at N.E. + pleasant course at W. Mid & Latter much the same Latter 10.16

Monday Feb 28th

First part trades at E course at W. Mid & Latter do Latter 11.46

Tuesday Feb 29th

First part trades E course at W. Mid do Latter light winds from E to E + rainy Latter 11.43

Wednesday March 1st

Light variable winds with rain + a heavy swell from the E caught 3 dolphins Mid do Latter light breeze from E steering at W. W. Latter 13.34 Long 141.3

Thursday March 2nd

First part center to N.E. at sunset breezing on + some rain at 8 P.M. took in the light sails + double reefed the top at 12 parted main sail again. Latter wind center. SE 15.00

Friday March 3rd 1848

Fresh trades E. & E + fine weather course at W. W. Mid do Latter moderate + cloudy repaired in top gal. sack Latter 16.25

Saturday March 4th

First part moderate breeze E. & E + cloudy Mid & Latter much the same broke out aft + cooped the salt provisions Latter 16.25

Sunday March 5th

First part fine breeze E & E course at W. W. W. stowed back provisions + opened all flour Mid & Latter from E. Latter 20.00 Long 154.10

Monday March 6th

First part moderate breeze from the E + strong at 4.20 saw Onychia 20 lbs with some new wheel ropes Mid strong trading course at W. W. at daylight E point of Moroe bore SE 15 lbs with one sail in sight Latter 20.00

Tuesday March 7th

Spined the buff + Port. Lined abreast the lowland becalmed with heaving into the bay at sunset took a light breeze from the N.E. + kept off for the passage at point of Moroe bearing W by N. 6 lbs with Mid run into the channel at daylight the Capt. went on shore at 9 A.M. came to anchor in 20 fath water on watch on liberty Latter 20.00

Wednesday March 8th

Fine weather sent 30 cash ashore for water on watch on shore took the raft on board pointed the stern + stowed water + 45 took on board 11 lbs potatoes Latter 20.00

Thursday March 9th

Discharged the men shipped here + approached I. S. Idles Latter 20.00
Shipped at I. S. Idles
Fine weather on watch on liberty + blacked the bentley repaired the wheel &c.

Friday March 10th

Fine weather watch on liberty the other employed various ways Latter 20.00

Saturday March 11th

Fine weather watch on liberty towed off raft water &c. Latter 20.00

Sunday March 12th

Fine weather on watch on liberty Johnnie Cook, assisted Latter 20.00

Monday March 13th

Strong trading stowed water grained the bentley &c. took on board 24 lbs fish potatoes Latter 20.00
