Tuesday March 14th 1848

Strong trade & fine weather took on board 2 bbls Salmon
1 do Syrup 64 lbs Sugar

Wednesday Mar 15th
Strong trading & fine weather one watch ashore

Thursday Mar 16th

Light air & fine weather one watch on blight took on board 2 bbls
wash potatoes 100 pumpkins a few bananas & Melons

Friday March 17th

Strong traded at 7 AM took the anchor Capt went on shore
at 10 returned with 10 men ship's crew & put off for anchor

Saturday Mar 18th

Strong traded at 7 Capt went ashore at Anahulu for men & mail
off at 10 latter do at

Sunday Mar 19th

Trade traded at 2 PM Capt came off with 2 men & put away
for 11 AM mill do latter light trade & overcast at 10 AM
made the 500

Monday Mar 20th

Light muggy E & SE & clouds with some rain at 11 Capt
went on shore at sunset returned & took to the S. Mill off on
latter wind all round compass & raining

Tuesday Mar 21st

Light variable air & calm some rain at 2 PM the Capt went on
shore with 2 boats trading at sunset returned with one pig & few onions
2 bush sweet potatoes &c. Mill light air & calm latter some rain
along the anchors without change

Wednesday Mar 22nd

Light variable winds & calm at 4 PM was boarded by Ship Eleanor
of Myslie 32 MS 1000 Mail much the same latter strong breeze
at 11 by the wind E & SE watch employed fitting bags for
potatoes &c.

Thursday Mar 23rd

Strong breeze at 11 PM took to the S. Mill employed before
mill & latter the same

Friday Mar 24th

Strong breeze at 11 PM steering by the wind at 11 PM latter men
on top & bent it Mail & latter much the same bent men
ph & stay sail whips & spencers &c.

Saturday Mar 25th

Strong breeze at 11 PM by the wind to the S. Mill & latter
wind at 11 PM fine weather steering at 11 PM repaired the

Sunday Mar 27th 1848

Came in with a light breeze at 11 PM & fine weather steering
at 11 PM mail do latter rainy wind came to at 11 PM. South
repaired the top &c.

Monday Mar 28th

First part fresh gale at 11 PM & some rain headed to the East
at sunset backed to the W. Mill & latter moats at 11 PM.
backed to the E broke out for water

Tuesday Mar 29th

Fresh gale at 11 PM at 11 PM & overcast backed to the N.W.
Mail & latter about the same repaired the top

Wednesday 29th

First part fresh gale at 11 PM & cloudy steering at 11 PM.
mail & latter foggy repaired the top

Wind came to the

Thursday Mar 30th

E & moderated all sail set steering at 11 PM.
mail & latter some fog repaired the mail

Friday Mar 31st

Weak breeze from the E & foggy steering at 11 PM. Mail &
latter much the same with some rain

Saturday Mar April 1st

Weak breeze SE & rainy course at 11 PM. Mail & latter do

Springing the top gear

Sunday April 2nd

First part light variable winds & rainy disagreeable weather
Mail much the same latter wind SE.

Monday April 3rd

Light breeze at 11 PM & rain steering at 11 PM. Some humpbacks
Mail do latter more pleasant fished the top

Tuesday April 4th

Strong breeze from the E & pleasant for this lat. steering
at 11 PM by 11 PM at 11 PM would repair the top Mail much the
same latter more moats repaired the top

Wednesday April 5th

Weak breeze from the E & fine weather Mail do latter
SE & foggy course at 11 PM by 11 PM opened the top & fresh catch
