

Ship Charles Drew for the Navigator 21st day

Sunday Nov 3rd 1848

First part strong trade steering S by W. finished
briling net hold for Mica & Latten the same Lat 4 52

Monday Nov 4th

Came in fresh trade E & N E course S by W. Mica &
Latten no broke out shocks for water &c. Lat 6 40

Tuesday Nov 5th

Fresh trade E & N E steering S by W. I employed setting
up shocks for water &c. Mica & Latten more moderate all
hands employed coopers oil in the storage

Wednesday Nov 6th

Light trade E & N E & fine weather course S by W. I
finished the oil in the storage put down each specim
(8 bbls) & stowed back the bone Mica & Latten much the
same coopers oil (pupet) in the fore hatch
opened bll port. Lat 9 2

Thursday Nov 7th

Fine weather finished coopers Mica the same Latten
shocks of rain setting up shocks for water
Lat 9 52

Friday Nov 8th

Moderate trade N E & a shower of rain course S by W &
Mica & Latten much the same Lat 11 12

Saturday Nov 9th

First part light breeze from S W to S E steering
S by W. Mica & Latten variable winds & showers of rain

Sunday Nov 10th

Light winds & showers of rain Mica & Latten fresh
breeze & squalls of rain from E to S E steering S by W
No Rain

Monday Nov 11th

Fresh trade E & S E. Mica light winds & showers of rain
at 1 P.M. saw the S.S. Upolu bearing S Latten light
trade E & S E standing in by the wind I for the harbour of
Salufata

Tuesday Nov 12th

At 2 P.M. took a pilot at 3 came to anchor in 8 fath water
& paid out 45 fath chain sent 12 pupet on shore for water
took up off & stowed it in the blubber room

Ship Charles Drew at Salufata harbour 22nd

Wednesday Nov 15 1848

Fine weather took on board 11 pupet water & 6 boatloads
wood opened bll bay & brook (opened bll floor)

Thursday Nov 16th

Fine weather I watch on liberty took on board 6 boatloads
wood

Friday Nov 17th

Fine weather I watch on liberty two of the watch pick
three intoxicated & the remainder stowing away wood &c.
took on board 10 logs

Saturday Nov 18th

Fine weather at 7 A.M. took the anchor & stood out
of the harbour discharged pilot stowed one anchor
&c.

Sunday Nov 19th

Going off & on for Monday to transact some business
with the Consul at Apia & M. below Mica & Latten
light winds at 10 A.M. Capt. went on shore

Monday Nov 20th

Light trade standing off & on at 1 P.M. came on board
discharged John Owens & shipped Edwin B. Webster
Mica & Latten working round the East end of the Is.

Tuesday Nov 21st

saw a schooner & a shoal black fish
Moderate trade N E by E by the wind to the E. at 7 P.M.
the most E. part of Upolu bore S by W. 12 M.
Totovilla in sight to the E. saw a shoal of blackfish
& a schooner (Mica variable winds & rain Latten as
steering S by E. no Rain)

Wednesday Nov 22nd

Fresh breeze from the N. course S by E. Mica much the
same Latten light winds E & S cloudy watch employed
reaving new running rigging &c. No Rain

Thursday Nov 23rd

Light winds E & N E & cloudy course S by E. opened bll
bay started pupet water &c. Mica & Latten wind from
N to S & some rain Lat 18 32

Friday Nov 24

Light winds from N to S W & spring steering S by E
Mica & Latten no
No Rain
