

Ship Charles Owen towards Cape Horn

Wednesday Jan'y 24 1849

Wind shifted to S.W. & blew fresh with snow & rain
close reefed the top hand sail for mamsail & Ma &
Latter more mott, made all sail saw two icebergs

Lat 57 21

Thursday Jan'y 25th

Fresh gales S.W. & some snow steering E. & E. Ma &
& Latter more passed two islands of ice broached bbl
flour & keg butter

Friday Jan'y 26th

Fresh gales N.W. to W. & rough steering E. & N. carried
away topmast sludding sail boom Ma & Latter blowing
fresh from the W. saw one iceberg

Lat 57 22

Saturday Jan'y 27th

Fresh gales W. S.W. & cloudy steering N. E. by E. passed
3 islands of ice Ma & Latter more mott Lat 56 46

Sunday Jan'y 28th

Light winds S.W. & cloudy all sail set steering N. E. by
Ma & Latter wind N. & W. & rainy No Obs

Monday Jan'y 29th

Fresh gales W. & some rain steering E. & E. Ma & Latter
foggy opened bbl beef & pork No Obs

Tuesday Jan'y 30th

Moder gales W. & foggy Ma & Latter the same saw an
iceberg Lat 56 40 Long 113 14

Wednesday Jan'y 31st

Light winds N. & W. & some fog steering E. & E. Ma &
saw a Ship being to Latter much the same filled the butter

Thursday Feb'y 1st

Light winds from the W. steering E. & E. Ma & Latter the same
Lat 56 43 Long 107

Friday Feb'y 2nd

Came in with light winds N. & W. & pleasant all sail out
steering E. & E. Ma & Latter about the same Lat 57 7
" E. by N.

Saturday Feb'y 3rd

Came in fine breeze N. & W. Ma & Latter the same

Lat 57 20 Long 94 45

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Sunday Feb'y 4th 1849

Fresh gales W. & W. & fine weather steering
E. & E. Ma & Latter wind N. & W. Lat 57 27

Monday Feb'y 5th

Fresh gales N. & W. & good weather steering N. E. by E. Ma &
do Latter light squalls of rain opened bbl Beef Lat 57 6 84 24

Tuesday Feb'y 6th

Fresh gales W. & fine weather course E. & E. Ma & Latter
mott breeze N. & W. Lat 56 50

Wednesday Feb'y 7th

Light winds N. & W. & fine weather spoke back White
of N York for California (76 days) Ma & Latter no saw a ship
bound to the E. Lat 56 39 77 40



Thursday Feb'y 8th

Light baffling winds from S to W. & passing squalls of
hail & rain Ma & Latter much the same Lat 56 37
Long 72 50

Friday Feb'y 9th

Fresh gales S. & W. & pleasant steering E. by N. & N.
passed a Spanish Ship bound to the W. Ma & Latter
light gale & calm at daylight saw the Diego's
bearing N. N. E. 20 Mys

Saturday Feb'y 10th

Came in with light winds E. & E. & some rain by
the wind to the S. E. one sail in sight Ma & Latter
wind venting gradually to the S. Lat 57 47

Sunday Feb'y 11th

Fresh gales N. & W. & some rain by the wind N. & E.
opened bbl Beef & Pork Ma & Latter wind S.W.
& cloudy saw a ship bound to the E. Lat 55 51 Long 62 44
fitted all mott

Monday Feb'y 12th

Came in the same steering N. & W. Ma & Latter fresh
gales from S. steering N. W. Lat 53 6 Long 63 45

Tuesday Feb'y 13th

Last part fresh breeze I all sail out steering N. & W. by
Ma & Latter W. & W. at daylight saw the foggy side
bearing N. & N. E. to the S. W. Latter the same Lat 51 42
