

Ship Charles Owen from Rio de Janeiro

Monday March 3rd 1849

Fresh gales N & W & rugged steering N & E. Ship making
some considerable water. Mid & Latte moderate made all
sail No Ob

Tuesday March 4th

Came in with fresh gales N & W & cloudy, after rain
broke out for water. Mid & Latte fine weather
repairing in sail Lat 33 13

Wednesday 5th Long 42 -

Light winds S & fine weather steering N & E by E.
Mid much the same Latte calm one sail in light match
employed fitting & painting royal gas Latitude 32 29

Thursday March 6th

Light winds N & W & fine weather course N & E by E
Mid & Latte light winds Lat 31 58

Friday March 7th

Light breeze S & E by the wind N & E. Mid & Latte from
gales & squalls of rain took in the light sails saw
a ship & boat bound to the S Lat 30 21

Saturday March 8th Long 39 16

Fresh gales from the E with little rain at 5 P.M.
doubt reefed the top steering to the wind to the S.
Mid about the same Latte more moderate Lat 29 --

Sunday March 9th

Fresh gales E & fine weather by the wind N & E.
saw a Brig standing to the S. Mid & Latte about
the same opened pipe bread Lat 27 3

Monday March 10th

Fresh breeze from the E steering by the wind N & E
passed a Brig bound S. Mid & Latte much the same
saw two sail steering to the S Lat 25 23

Tuesday March 11th Long 39 30

Light winds E & N & fine weather by the wind N.
Pent Miz top gale sail opened all but 1 & 2
Mid & Latte at E tacked E & E Lat 24 9

Wednesday March 12th

Light winds & fine weather at 3 P.M. tacked N by the
Pent up main royal mast. Mid tacked to the E Latte
the same Lat 24 12

Towards the Line & Home

Thursday March 13th 1849

Light breeze N & steering by the wind N & E. Employed
mending sails & Mid & Latte wind N & E heading
E & E by E Lat 24 26

Friday March 14th

Strong trades N & E by the wind N & E. Mid & Latte
squally, doubt reefed fore & Miz top No Ob

Saturday March 15th

Came in with fresh gales & squally N & E.
by the wind E saw a schooner, bound to the S.
Mid had beat sea & squally rain & ship heaving 300
strokes per hour. Latte wind shifted to the N & steering
Lat 33 59 Long 32

Sunday March 16th

Fresh breeze S & squally, made all sail steering N & E
Mid & Latte fine weather Lat 32 25

Monday March 17th Long 30 31 12

Fine breeze S & pleasant course N & E by E. Mid & Latte
much the same at day light. In the afternoon E 20 m
at 10 two boats went in fishing Lat 30 30

Tuesday March 18th

Came in fine breeze S & E at 6 boats returned to
the ship with about fifty fish & minus one boat
anchor set lower topmast & top gale studding
sails & steered N by E. Mid & Latte wind N & E
opened all but crossed fore & Miz royal gas Lat 18 20

Wednesday March 19th

Light winds E & E & calm making running rigging &
Mid light breeze E & showers of rain Latte wind from E to
N & squally saw a ship bound S at 10 tacked to the N & W
making running rigging out of top gales Lat 17 30

Thursday March 20th

Light variable winds & rainy several sail in sight.
Mid & Latte light winds from the E & showers of rain
watch making rigging Lat 16 50

Friday March 21st

Came in with fresh breeze E & squally. 3 sail in sight
Mid & Latte the same Lat 15 17
