Saturday March 25th 1849

Came in with a strong breeze from the E & squally
stems, at 6 P.M. left the two sail return mid & latter
about the same passed Eng Bank. Iron Mid Lat 13 11 38 37

Sunday March 26th

Fresh calms E by S & squally steering N by E. Mid do
Latter from N E to E by S Lat 11 5

Monday March 26th

Came in about the same Mid & latter do employ
various ways took the monkey sail off, took down the
house & filled the butts Lat 8 56

Tuesday March 27th

Came in with light trades E & fine weather repair
ing bulworks sheeting heading up shock heads hoops
&c. opened oil beef & pork one sail in sight Mid
& latter E & S set the studding sails Lat 7 8 Long 28 46
3 sail in sight

Wednesday March 28th

Light trades N E & fine weather watch employed on
the rigging &c. Mid & latter wind from E to N E employ
bunching board Lat 5 42

Thursday March 29th

Light breeze N & E by the sand at 4 P.M. finished the bone
Mid & latter light wind & fine weather Lat 4 52

Friday March 30th 5 0 30 25

Light wind & calm fitting, rigging Mid & latter light breeze
E to E N E setting rigging Bark to leeward Lat 3 44

Saturday March 31st

Light breeze E N E by the wind to the st. Mid & latter
light wind & rainy Lat 2 36

Sunday April 1st

Light variable winds & some rain Mid & latter
light breeze S E & fine weather saw a ship steering
to the N E Lat 1 41

Monday April 2nd

Light breeze S E & pleasant - courses set E. Mid
& latter calm & rainy Lat 1 15

Tuesday April 3rd

First part calm all hands swimming in the
evening Mid & latter light wind & calm at 9
opened oil beef & setting rigging

Wednesday April 4th 1849

Light wind & calm Mid & latter wind to the st. &
squally of rain one sail in sight No Obs

Thursday April 5th

Light wind from st. & squally Mid & latter light
wind & calm Lat 11 31 15

Friday April 6th

First part calm Mid & latter light winds & sea
& squally of rain (filled the butts)

Saturday April 7th

Light winds N E to S N E & squally of rain Mid
latter fresh trades & squally Lat 1 33 S

Sunday April 8th

Fresh trades N E & squally of rain steering S W
N. Mid & latter the same split the jib No Obs

Monday April 9th

Strong trades & squally Mid & latter the same
Lat 4 31

Tuesday April 10th

Breeze trades N N E & pleasant by the wind
st. Mid & latter about the same Lat 6 30

Wednesday April 11th

Strong breeze N E & pleasant course at 4 by N
Mid & latter do

Thursday April 12th

Strong trades & pleasant steering at W. & at
opened oil beef & pork Mid & latter moderate
Lat 9 49

Friday April 13th 4 43 43

Moderate trades & pleasant. Mid & latter the same
watch employed tarring rigging &c. Lat 11 24

Saturday April 14th

Moderate breeze E N E & fine weather steering at W.
N. Mid & latter the same Lat 13 18

Sunday April 15th

Came in the same Mid & latter do
Lat 14 42 Long 48
