

Round to the Arctic

Friday May the 10th 1850

Begins with strong wind from the North West ship under double reef by the wind larboard tacks aboard Midell & Latter Parts strong winds from the West North West ship heading North under double reefed top sails & courses overcast weather so ends this Day

Lat 37° 08'

Long 166° 23'

Saturday the 11th

Begins with strong winds from the West ship heading North Middle Part strong winds from the West North West an frequent rain squalls Latter Part more moderate from the North W by North ship heading North East by North so ends this Day

Lat 38° 07'

Sunday the 12th

Begins with a moderate breeze from the West & a heavy sea ship heading North North West Middle Part strong winds from the West south West ship heading North West Latter Part much the same

Lat 39° 56'

Monday the 13th

Begins with strong winds from the Westward Middle & Latter Parts more moderate from the West ship heading North North West East

Lat 40° 29'

Long 163° 16'

Round to the Arctic Ocean

Tuesday May the 14th 1850

Begins with moderate breezes from the North West ship heading North North East with frame Middle & Latter Parts strong winds & squalls from the West North West so ends this Day

Lat 41° 46'

Wednesday the 15th

Begins with strong winds from the West North West ship heading North Middle & Latter Parts much the same thus ends the Day

Lat 42° 44'

Long 160° 19'

Thursday the 16th

Begins with moderate breezes from North West by W ship heading North by East Middle & Latter light variable winds from the Westward

Lat 43° 56'

Long 160° 10'

Friday the 17th

Begins with light variable winds from the Westward Middle & Latter Parts light variable winds from the Southward & fine weather steering West North West so ends this Day

Lat 44° 51'

Long 160° 26'

Saturday the 18th

Begins with light airs from the South West ship heading West North West fine weather Middle Part much the same Latter Part light winds from the Southward steering West North West

Lat 45° 34'

Long 162° 02'
