

In the sea of Anadir

Thursday August the 15th 1850

Begins with a fresh breeze from the West ship heading South South West the watch employed in scraping bone middle part light winds from West South West ship on the larboard tack heading North West latter part light winds from the West ship heading South South West the watch employed in scraping bone

Friday the 16th

Begins with fresh breezes from the west & fine weather ship heading S S West the watch employed as above middle part the wind S S West ship heading West latter part

Saturday the 17th

Whose 24 hours fine weather Lat 63° 04' Long 179° 34' saw the land

Sunday the 18th

Begins with light winds from the Eastward & fine weather the land in sight middle part light winds from the Southward latter part from the Eastward ship steering to the south so ends this Day Lat 62° 35'

Monday the 19th

Begins with a strong breeze from the East ships course South Half West saw a right whale cow & calf lowered for them without success Middle & latter parts strong winds from the North East steering South South West so ends this Day Lat 61° 15'

Tuesday August the 20th 1850

Begins with a light breeze from the North steering South South West overcast but good weather middle part calm latter part light airs from the South all hands employed in stowing down 9 bbls of oil so ends this Day No observation

Wednesday the 21st

Begins with light winds & pleasant weather from the Southward the ship on the Western tack middle & latter parts light winds from the South & thick fog the watch employed in stowing down oil so ends this Day No observation

Thursday the 22nd

Begins with light winds from the Southward & thick fog middle part the wind South East by East steering South South West latter part the wind East & good weather so ends this Day Lat 58° 12' Long 173° 06' East

Saturday the 23rd

Begins with light winds from the South East & good weather steering South West middle part light winds from the South & thick weather latter part light winds from the South South East overcast weather & thick by spells so ends this Day No observation
