

Remarks on board off Kamtschataka

Saturday August the 24th 1850
Begins with light winds from the South South East &
rainy steering South West middle & latter parts light airs &
calms or clear weather so ends this Day

Lat 56 47"
Long 169 52" East

Sunday the 25th
Begins with light winds from the westward
& overcast weather middle part light variable winds
latter part light winds from the South West
so ends this Day

Monday the 26th
Begins with light airs from the South
West & good weather middle part much the
same latter parts light winds from the
Eastward & overcast weather so ends this Day
No observation

Tuesday the 27th
Begins with light winds from the Eastward
overcast weather middle part light winds
from the South East & thick rainy weather
latter part a fresh breeze from the Eastward
& thick rainy weather so ends this Day

Remarks on board off Kamtschataka

Wednesday August the 28th 1850
Begins with light winds from the East
& thick rainy weather ship under short
sail had soft biscuit for supper this is
the second time since we left home
middle part light winds from the Eastward
latter part the wind South East at 5 A.M.
saw Bhearings Island bearing South East
by South saw several humpbacks &
finbacks so ends this Day

No observation

Thursday the 29th
Begins with light winds from South
East by South & overcast with some rain
Bhearings Island bearing East South
East middle part rainy dirty weather
steering South South West latter part
light winds from the Eastward overcast
weather saw finbacks ship on the
Southern tack so ends this Day

No observation

Friday the 30th
Begins with light airs from the
South East overcast weather ship
heading South South West middle
part the wind East North East
steering South West by South
latter part a fresh breeze from the South East
& tolerable clear steering West at 10 saw
land bearing North West a part of Kamtschataka
