Friday
Nov 11

All these twentyfour hours strong winds from NW the first part steering SE & thick weather the middle & latter part steering E by S. Clear weather employed in picking up mizen & fore topgallant sails & large quarters of sails & ends this day
Obs Lat 35° 10' S Long 28° 09' East

Saturday
Nov 12

Commenced with strong gales from NW steering SE & at 7 PM took in mizen topgallant single reefed the fore middle part the same latter part more moderate set single reefed mizen topgallant & fore topgallant sail heavy sea running saw Finback's & ends
Obs Lat 35° 08' S Long 3° 55' East

Sunday
Nov 13

First part of this day strong winds from NW steering SE by S middle & latter part more moderate & pleasant weather saw Finback's & ends these twentyfour hours
Obs Lat 35° 28' S Long 7° 16' East

Monday
Nov 14

This day begins with brisk wind from NW & pleasant steering SE by S middle part the same latter part clearing with some rain at noon more pleasant employed in ship's duty & ends
Obs Lat 35° 51' S Long 10° 13' East

Tuesday
Nov 15

All these twentyfour hours strong winds from NW & clearing steering SE employed in ship's duty at noon wind increases took in fore topgallant sail single reefed the fore topgallant sail the mizen saw Finback's & ends
Obs Lat 37° 36' South

Wednesday
Nov 16

Commenced with strong gales from NW & thick weather steering SE at 5 PM 2 reefs fore & main topgallant sails heavy sea at 11 PM took a large sea & shore the waist boat latter part more moderate set topgallant sails over single reefed topgallant the mizen & fore topgallant sails saw Finback's & ends these twentyfour hours
Obs Lat 38° 38' S Long 11° 57' East

Thursday
Nov 17

These twentyfour hours begins with strong wind from NW steering SE at 12 PM heavy squalls of wind & rain reduced to 2 reefs fore & main topgallant sails the same latter part more moderate made sail to fore & main topgallant sails over single reefed topgallant sails steering SE by S saw Finback's & ends Albert boardman sick off duty
Obs Lat 38° 32' S Long 20° 02' East

Friday
Nov 18

First part of this day fresh wind from NW steering SE middle part baffling latter part more NW steering E some squalls employed in ship's duty saw Finback's & ends Albert boardman sick off duty & ends these twentyfour hours a large turtle
Obs Lat 38° 18' S Long 24° 54' East

Saturday
Nov 19

Commenced with brisk wind from NW steering E employed in felling saw main topgallant middle part light wind & baffling latter part light wind from the southward & clearing steering E by S saw Finback's & ends No Obs

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Sunday
Nov 20

This day begins with light winds from SE head & the middle part wind 3 NE to 4 E head SE to ESE latter part wind N steering E by S saw Finback's & ends
Obs Lat 36° 38' S Long 28° 39' East

Monday
Nov 21

Commenced with strong winds from N steering E by S at 2 PM wind hauled to NW strong gales & squalls at 6 PM reduced to 2 reefs topgallant middle part the same steering SE by E latter part more moderate let one reef out topgallant saw nothing & ends
Obs Lat 35° 08' S Long 32° 28' East

Tuesday
Nov 22

First part of this day strong winds from N steering SE by S middle & latter part light wind from NW employed in felling saw fore & foretopgallant at 12 PM finished about foretopgallant to mizen saw Finback's & ends these twentyfour hours No Obs

Wednesday
Nov 23

These twentyfour hours begins with light winds from NW steering SE by E employed in mending fore topgallant at 5 PM bent it middle part calm latter part employed in mending foresail the mizen & fore topgallant sails saw Finback's & ends got out fresh water
Obs Lat 36° 08' S Long 36° 34' East

Thursday
Nov 24

This day begins with strong wind from N steering SE by E employed in mending foresail at 12 PM took in topgallant sails the mizen & fore topgallant sails at 4 PM bent foresail 2 reefs the topgallant sails at 10 PM strong gales & squalls took in fore & mizen topgallant sails main sail & jib at 2 PM the wind hauled to NW & more moderate made sail at 5 PM squally reefed the topgallant sails the wind NW at 8 PM more pleasant made sail employed in mending fore topgallant sails saw Finback's & ends
Obs Lat 35° 30' S Long 39° 26' East

Friday
Nov 25

Commenced with strong winds from N steering SE by E at 2 PM took in topgallant sails at 6 PM 2 reefs topgallant sails the wind NW at 8 PM washed a man overboard from the fore chain backed the main yard lowered boat & picked him up took in main sail mizen topgallant & jib wind NW by S steering SE latter part more moderate let one reef out topgallant set main sail & jib steering SE by E saw Finback's & ends
Obs Lat 31° 54' S Long 42° 05' East

Saturday
Nov 26

First part of this day strong wind from S head & SE under single reefed topgallant at 6 PM 2 reefs topgallant latter part pleasant all sail set employed in mending fore topgallant sail at 12 PM finished & bent it on board spanker & bent storm mizen & foretopgallant sails this day head E to ESE
Obs Lat 31° 21' S Long 45° 54' East
