

Ship Charter & Logs of Stonington 1844

Monday
April 1

Commences with strong gales from E & thick
snow storm at 6 AM pleasant all hands
employed in clearing the snow off decks & getting
out fresh water the middle & latter parts clear
weather lowered the sails to haul off the ice
waiting for a chance to get underway at 3
PM wind stop & have short the main sheet hauled
to N E made out the chain & let her lay for the
night to order rather impatient to get home

Tuesday
April 2

Commences with brisk wind from the northward
& clear weather at 7 AM took the anchor &
stood down through Fishers Island Sound & came
to anchor in this 4 fathoms hole furlled the
sails & went home so ends the voyage

Voyage began, Aug. 29th 1842
" ended, April 2^d 1844
