 Saturday Commences with a strong gale from S W
 Oct the 11 heading S E at 5 a m took in the fore sail
 at 12 the wind hauled to S W by W and moderated
 at 1 p m kept the off E and set the fore sail
 shook a reef out of the main top sail unbent the
 fore top sail and bent another double reefed
 & set it at 5 p m shook the reefs out of the main
 top sail and set the 5th & steered S by E

Sunday This day begins with a strong breeze from S W and
 Oct the 12 squally at 1 p m it moderated shook the reefs out
 of the fore & mizzen top sails and set the main
 top gallant sail steering S E middle part of
 wind latter part a fresh breeze from W to S W

Monday All of these 24 hours a fresh breeze from S W
 Oct the 13 W & W and cloudy weather at 5 a m took in
 main top gallant sail at 7 split the main
 sail unbent it and bent the new one at 1 p m
 set the main top gallant sail bent a new one
 forward and set it steering S E saw nothing

Tuesday These 24 hours commences with light winds from
 Oct the 14 S W and pleasant steering S E employed in repairing
 the close mizzen middle part light baffling airs & c
 have new fore & main top sail & fore braces taken
 light airs from S E & ship heading S Obs Lat 43.40 Long 179

Wednesday Commences with a fresh breeze from S E ship heading
 Oct the 15 S E and thick weather at 6 a m it breezed on took
 in the top gallant sails at 7 double reefed the top sail
 at 2 p m have the ship too under double reef main top sail & fore
 sail at 6 close reefed the main top sail & took in the fore sail blowing

 Thursday These 24 hours commences with a gale from S E ship heading
 the 16 too heading S E at 1 a m the wind shifted to S W and
 moderated made sail and steered S E middle &
 latter part strong winds from W to W N W steering S by E

Commences with a fresh breeze from S W and pleasant
 the 17 steering S by E set the fore & main top gallant
 sails middle & latter part light baffling winds
 and calms bent the new main top gallant sail
 employed in mending the waist boat & c
 Obs Lat 42.26 & Long 176.51

Friday Begins with light airs and calms at 5 a m a breeze springing
 up from S by E ship heading S E by S with cloudy weather
 employed in mending the waist boat latter
 part a fresh breeze from S by S ship heading S by E
 took in the flying 5th & mizzen top gallant sail

Saturday This day commences with a fresh breeze from S by S
 the 19 ship heading S E by S at 5 a m took in the top gallant
 sails at 2 p m double reefed the top sails took
 in main sail & 5th at 4 took in the fore and
 mizzen top sails at 6 closed reefed the main top
 sail and took in the fore sail blowing heavy

Sunday These 24 hours commences with a strong gale from S ship
 the 20 heading S S at 1 a m it moderated made sail at 8 shook
 the reefs out of the top & set main top gallant sail middle
 part calm and thick fog at 2 p m a light breeze sprang up
 from W steering S by S Obs Lat 39.41 & Long 177.50

Monday All of these 24 hours light winds from W & W steering S
 the 21 by S first part foggy latter part pleasant steering
 S & bent the new fore top sail saw nothing to mend
 Obs Lat 39.05 & Long 178.43
