 Sunday These 24 hours commences with a strong breeze from
 Nov the 2 N by E and squally steering E by S under double reef fore &
 & main top sail & fore sail at 6 A.M. it moderated
 set the main sail & set at 9 shook the reefs out
 the top sails at 11 set the top gallant sails later
 a fresh breeze so ends Obs Lat 35.48 Long 157.33

Monday Commences with light winds from NW to SW
 Nov the 3 and cloudy weather steering E by S middle &
 latter part strong winds and squally at 12 A.M. took
 in top mast studding sail and the top gallant
 sails employed in fitting a brotched yard out of the
 spare top sail yard saw nothing so ends

Tuesday All of these 24 hours strong winds from SW steering
 Nov the 4 E by S under fore & main top sail and fore sail
 first part rainy latter part pleasant so ends
 Obs Lat 36.58 Long 152.17

Wednesday Commences with a strong breeze from SW and overcast
 Nov the 5 steering E by S middle & latter part baffling wind
 from S to W and squally with some rain
 Obs Lat 37.18 Long 149.29

Thursday This day begins with a strong breeze from SW to W
 Nov the 6 and squally steering E by S middle part light baffling
 winds & rainy latter part a fresh breeze from W
 saw nothing so ends Obs Lat 37.38 Long 147.23

Friday These 24 hours commences with a strong breeze from
 Nov the 7 N by E and squally steering E by S middle & latter
 part light northerly winds and pleasant made
 all sail bent the new mizen top sail so ends
 Obs Lat 37.23 Long 144.30 W

 Saturday Commences with light baffling airs and calms
 fine pleasant weather at 10 P.M. a light breeze
 sprang up from S W steering E by S with all sail
 set latter part a fresh breeze employed in chasing
 ship saw nothing so ends Obs Lat

Sunday All of these 24 hours a brisk wind from S by E
 Nov the 9 to S W and cloudy weather steering E by S with
 all sail set saw nothing so ends
 Obs Lat 37.55 Long 139.12 W

Monday These 24 hours commences with a strong breeze from S
 Nov the 10 to S W and overcast at 2 P.M. took in the fore & mizen
 top gallant sails and top mast studding sail at day
 light set them again steering E by S latter part light
 winds from W and pleasant Obs Lat 38.16 Long 135.35 W

Tuesday Begins with a light air from W and pleasant
 Nov the 11 steering E by S with all sail set middle & latter
 part a fresh breeze from S by E to S W saw nothing
 so ends Obs Lat 38.15 Long 133.34 W

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze from
 Nov the 12 N by E and overcast steering E by S with all sail
 set middle part pleasant with wind from SW employed
 in packing bone latter part the wind NW
 saw nothing so ends Obs Lat 38.08 Long 130.00 W

Thursday This day commences with a fresh breeze from
 Nov the 13 N W and squally steering E by S with all
 sail set middle & latter part light
 baffling winds and pleasant employed
 in drying bone and packing of st saw nothing
 so ends Obs Lat 37.56 Long 128.04 W
