 watch ashore on liberty the cooper setting up hook
 the Capt. went to Yerba Buena with Capt Barnham

Sunday Commences with a brisk wind from the northward
 Nov the 30 and pleasant weather the Starboard watch
 ashore on liberty employed in filling water 80
 at 2 P.M. the Capt got back from Yerba Buena

Monday All of these 24 hours light northerly winds and pleasant
 Dec the 1 weather all hands on liberty this being the Sabbath

at San Francisco November 1845

Tuesday This day light northerly winds and pleasant weather
 Nov the 2 the Starboard watch ashore on liberty the Starboard
 watch employed in painting on boat gone 40 miles
 up the bay with trade So Ends

Wednesday First part of this day thick fog Middle & latter
 Nov the 3 part pleasant on watch ashore on liberty the other
 employed in ships duty at 8 P.M. the came back
 from up the bay So Ends

Thursday All of these 24 hours light northerly winds
 Nov the 4 and pleasant weather all hands employed
 in getting of water and stowing of it got of some
 potatoes So Ends

Friday Commences with fine pleasant weather
 Nov the 5 all hands employed in stowing water between
 decks on boat gone across the bay to get beef

Saturday All of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
 Nov the 6 all hands employed in getting off wood
 and water So Ends

Sunday These 24 commences with light winds from
 Nov the 7 N.W. and pleasant weather on watch ashore
 on liberty the other employed in stowing
 away wood and water So Ends

Monday All of these 24 hours light northerly winds and
 Nov the 8 pleasant weather the watch ashore on
 liberty

Tuesday These 24 hours commences with light winds
 Nov the 9 from the northward and pleasant weather employed
 in getting off wood and water
