

Ship Charles Phelps of Stonington

Thursday Begins with light northerly winds and pleasant weather
Dec the 20 Steering S by E for the Island of St Barbara in the morning light airs and calm at 9 a m got up with 7 miles of the Island sent 4 boats 2 from Ship to look for Elephant latter part calm the ships drifted off a good way from the Island out of sight from the boats hauled up the boats on the beach and encamped for the night so ends

Friday Commences with light light baffling wind working
Dec the 21 up for the Island pleasant weather at 9 a m the boats got on board latter part light westerly wind Steering E by N Saw Humphreys
Obs Lat 33.11 N Long 118.40 W

Saturday All of these 24 hours light baffling airs and calm
Dec the 22 pleasant weather Steering E by S with all sail set the watch employed in making Spanish

Sunday Commences with light baffling airs and calm
Dec the 23 pleasant weather Steering E by S with all sail set latter part light wind from NW at 5 p m hauled up NE for Port Diego the employees in ships duty at 7 p m the wind NW Ship heading S by E
Long by Lunar 117.14 W Obs Lat 32.34 N Long 117.18 W

Monday These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze
Dec the 24 from NW and pleasant weather Ship standing off and on at St Diego the Warsaw stood in & came to anchor middle part calm latter a light breeze from NW at 5 p m stood off the mouth of Harbor and sent in a boat found 5 American traders 2 of them bound home put latter on board at 5 p m kept off and steered E by S in company with the Warsaw

On the Coast of California Dec 1845

Tuesday Commences with a light breeze from NW
Dec the 25 and pleasant weather Steering S by E with all sail set at 3 a m hauled the ship S by W middle & latter part a fresh breeze and overcast in company with the Warsaw
So ends Obs Lat 31.22 N

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with a fresh
Dec the 26 breeze from NW and pleasant Steering S by W with all sail set at 8 a m raised the Island of San Daloupe bearing S by N distant 30 miles at sun down run down to the S end of the Island and hauled off shore so ends
Obs Lat 29.11 N Long 118.17 W

Thursday First part of these 24 hours a fresh breeze
Dec the 27 from NW and pleasant Ship lying off and on the Island of San Daloupe at 8 a m 2 boats went ashore to look for Elephant in company with the Warsaw's boats at 4 past 4 came on board did not find any latter part baffling airs and calm Ship heading E

Friday All of these 24 hours a fresh breeze from NW to N
Dec the 28 and pleasant Steering E with all sail set at 5 p m Capt. Rundleton went on board of Warsaw and Mr. Durfee their 2nd Officer came on board with him to work his passage to the Islands on account of difficulty with the Captain so ends
Obs Lat 28.18 N Long 116.26 W

Saturday Commences with a light breeze from N and pleasant
Dec the 29 Steering E by S at daylight raised the Ceros and Benito Islands at 1 p m sent 2 boats to the Benito Island to look for Elephant but found none so ends
