 employed in ships duty. So Ends
 Obs Lat 20.44 N Long 109.38 W

Sunday First part of these 24 hours calm pleasant
 Jan the 25 weather latter part light winds from N to
 N E Steering W. S. with all sail set. So Ends
 Obs Lat 20.42 N Long 110.15 W

Monday These 24 hours commences with a brisk wind
 Jan the 26 from N to N E and pleasant Steering W. S.
 latter part light baffling winds and easy
 So Ends No Obs

Tuesday Commences with a fresh breeze from N to N E
 Jan the 27 and pleasant Steering W. S. employed in fitting
 boats and setting up rigging latter part squally and
 raining with thunder and lightning. So Ends
 Obs Lat 20.54 N Long 113.04 W

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with a brisk wind with
 Jan the 28 squalls of rain Steering W. S. latter part brisk
 wind from N to N E and pleasant ship heading
 from N to N E So Ends Obs Lat 20.38 N Long 115.23 W

Thursday These 24 hours fresh breezes from N by W to N
 Jan the 29 and pleasant weather ship heading W. S. to
 W S W employed in fitting rigging and boat cut
 7 p in the wind hauled to N E Steering W
 So Ends Obs Lat 20.08 N Long 117.22 W

Friday All of these 24 hours fresh breezes from N by W to N
 Jan the 30 and pleasant weather Steering W. S. employed in
 taring rigging. So Ends Obs Lat 20.18 N Long 119.37 W

Saturday bound to the Sandwich Islands Feb. 1846
 Commences with a fresh breeze from N to N E and
 Jan the 31 and pleasant weather Steering W. S. with all
 sail set the watch employed in taring rigging
 and putting up a new fore top mast stay
 saw nothing. So Ends Obs Lat 20.23 N Long 122.07 W

Sunday These 24 hours commences with brisk winds from
 Jan the 1 N E to E and overcast Steering W. S. with all sail
 latter part squally. So Ends No Obs

Monday All of these 24 hours fresh breezes from N E to
 Jan the 2 E with some squalls Steering W. S. the watch
 employed in taring rigging saw nothing
 So Ends Obs Lat 20.35 N Long 127.15 W

Tuesday All of these 24 hours brisk winds from E N E
 Jan the 3 to E and squally weather Steering W. S. with
 all sail set saw nothing. So Ends
 Obs Lat 20.43 N Long 129.27 W

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with fresh winds E N E
 Jan the 4 and squally weather Steering W. S. latter part more
 moderate the watch employed in taring rigging
 saw nothing. So Ends Obs Lat 20.55 N Long 132.32 W

Thursday Commences with a light breeze from E N E to E
 Jan the 5 and pleasant weather Steering W. S. with all
 sail set employed in taring rigging &c.
 latter part fresh breeze saw nothing. So Ends
 Obs Lat 20.00 N Long 134.27 W

Friday Begins with a light wind from E and pleasant
 Jan the 6 weather Steering W. S. latter part fresh breeze from
 E N E employed in wetting hole painting boats
 &c. So Ends Obs Lat 20.55 N Long 136.37 W
