Latter part pleasant weather saw nothing
so ends Obs Lat 20.52 Long 141.15 W

Monday These 24 Commences with a fresh breeze from
Feb. the 9 E by N to E and squally. Steering W by S Latter
part pleasant weather the watch employed
in ships duty so ends Obs Lat 21.02 Long 144.09 W

Tuesday Commences with brisk wind from E by N to E
Feb. the 10 and squally weather. Steering W by S Latter
part light winds the watch employed in
ships duty so ends Obs Lat 21.08 Long 146.25 W

Wednesday Begins with brisk winds from E and squally
Feb. the 11 weather. Steering W by S Latter part light
winds employed in making wheel ropes and
lance warp so ends Obs Lat 21.08 Long 148.25 W

Thursday These 24 hours brisk winds from E to ESE
Feb. the 12 and pleasant weather. Steering W by S
with all sail set employed in painting the
lower mast starboard boat. Obs saw nothing
so ends Obs Lat 21.18 Long 150.46 W

Friday Begins with a fresh breeze from ESE and
Feb. the 13 pleasant weather. Steering W by S
chilled & Latter part light baffling wind
and evening so ends Obs

Saturday All of these 24 hours light wind from
Feb. the 14 ESE to ESE and pleasant weather. Steering
W by S with all sail set the watch employed
in ships duty Obs Lat 21.03 Long 153.48 W

Sunday Commences with light easterly winds and
Feb. the 15 pleasant. Steering W by S chilled part squally
at 6 a.m. raised the Island of Owhyhee
bearing S W Latter part light winds at sun down
the last point of Chowee bearing S W by W distant
25 miles Obs Lat 20.46 Long 155.05 W

Monday These 24 hours commences with a light
Feb. the 16 breeze from E and pleasant weather. Steering
W by S at 7 a.m. entered passage between
Chowee & Morotoi at 10 a.m. came too
set go the anchor in 10 fathoms of water
at Lahaina found 11 ships lying here

Tuesday All of these 24 hours light air and pleasant
Feb. the 17 weather one watch ashore on liberty the
other employed in painting. Sailed got a
raft of cash ashore for water and got off
31 barrels of Irish Potatoes. All of the
liberty men came off but one Charles Johnson

Wednesday Commences with a light southerly wind
Feb. the 18 and pleasant weather one watch on liberty
the employed in ships duty got off a raft of
water & 70 Gall of cholasses all of the liberty
men came off but 2 the Cooper & William Burton
