

Remarks when upon the whale ground in 1846

Wednesday. Commenced with light breeze from the
June 5th. Northward and Eastward. Ship heading
S. E. two ships in sight at 4 A. M. made sail at
8 the weather foggy. The middle part thin fog at
8 A. M. lower part of boats for whale that were galloped
and not strike. at 8 took in sail heading South
wind from N. E. W. thus ends in the

Latitude of 55° 01' North
Longitude of 143° 00' West

Thursday Begins with strong breeze from N. E. W.
June 6th ship heading to the southward. at 8
A. M. set double reef to top of fore and aft at 9
were ship head. Mr. water employed in repairing the
old mainmast. saw two ships. northward the middle
part. wind strong. at 9 A. M. took in sail heading
South thus ends in the

Latitude of 55° 06' North
Longitude of 143° 03' West

Friday Begins with strong breeze from N. E. W.
June 7th at 4 A. M. made sail steady to the Northward
at 12 noon. Left off to S. E. saw no whale water
employed in repairing sails at sunset took in sail heading
S. E. W. thus ends in the — Latitude 55° 09' North
Longitude of 143° 27' West

Saturday. Begins with strong breeze from S. E. W.
June 8th at 4 A. M. made sail heading S. E. saw
several finbacks. water employed in repairing the old
foretopail. at 8 A. M. double reef to the top of fore
and aft. at dark took in sail were ship heading
N. thus ends in the Latitude of 55° 22' North
Longitude of 143° 39' West

Remarks when cruising on the West coast in 1846

Sunday — Commenced with strong breeze from S. E. W.
June 9th at 3 A. M. made sail steady S. E. W.
saw two ships at 1 A. M. were ship heading East
saw no whale. at 8 were again at 8 spoke the
United States. Capt. Stephens on board this morning
at 8 took in sail wind heavy thus ends

Latitude of 55° 07' North
Longitude of 143° 11' West

Monday Begins with heavy gale from S. E. W.
June 10th the ship lying to under close reef.
main top weather rising. the middle and bottom
part the same thus ends no observation

Tuesday. Begins with strong gale from South
June 11th at 7 A. M. were ship set the top of
the weather unpleasant. saw one ship the middle
part foggy heavy sea. at dark took in sail heading
South wind from N. E. W. weather strong thus ends

Latitude of 55° 28' North
Longitude of 143° 04' West

Wednesday — Begins with heavy gale from
June 12th N. E. W. the ship lying to weather
raining. ship heading South the middle and bottom
part rather more moderate made no sail. thus
ends in the Latitude of 55° 16' North

Thursday Begins with strong breeze from N. E. W.
June 13th A. M. made sail steady to the Northward saw
two ships at 6 were ship stood to the southward middle and
bottom part the same water employed in mending topails

Latitude of 54° 28' North
