Remarks upon our passage from the NW coast to Maui

Friday Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. July 31st. Ship under all sail course S by E. at 5 A.M. bent new main top and topgall at 8 A.M. bent new main top and gave the mizzen and latter part pleasant weather employed in ships duty so much in the

Saturday 1st Begins with strong breeze July 1st August from N.E. ships course S by E the weather pleasant water employed in ships duty at 10 A.M. set lower studdsail at 3 P.M. set main topgall studdsail the latter part pleasant weather strong breeze so much in the
Latitude of 29° 47' North
Longitude 156° 43' West

Sunday
August 2nd Commenced with strong breeze from N.E. ships course S by E the weather squally at 4 P.M. saw a school of dolphins thought they might be. Spinnaker took in lower and topgall studdsails and hoisted up at 4 P.M. found out what they were kept off at 4 P.M. again the latter part squally thus much in the
Latitude of 33° 06' North
Longitude of 158° 52' West

Monday
August 3rd Begins with a fine breeze from N.E. the ships course S by E. all sail set the watches employed in washing water and ships duty the mizzen and latter part pleasant weather so much in the
Latitude of 34° 23' North
Longitude 159° 51' West

Tuesday Commenced with a fine breeze from August 4th. N.E. ships course S by E. all sail set. watches employed in ships duty the mizzen and latter part pleasant weather so much in the
Latitude of 29° 50' North
Longitude 156° 06'

Wednesday
August 5th Commenced with pleasant weather light trade winds. Ship under all sail course S by E. at 8 A.M. a fine breeze the water employed in washing ship the mizzen and latter part pleasant thus much in the
Latitude of 28° 18' North
Longitude 157° 16' West

Thursday
August 6th Commenced with strong N.E. trade winds ship under all sail course S by E. watches employed in washing ship outside the mizzen and latter part pleasant thus much in the
Latitude of 26° 42' North
Longitude 158° 52' West

Friday 7th
August 7th Begins with strong trade winds ship under all sail course S by E. watches employed in ships duty the mizzen and latter part pleasant thus much in the
Latitude of 24° 47' North
Longitude 159° 44' West

Saturday
August 8th Commenced with strong trade winds squally at 10 A.M. took in lower and topgall studdsails at 2 P.M. set them again at 7 P.M. main topgallant hoisted black top and one left latter part pleasant
Latitude 25° 49' N Long 161° 14'
