from S by E to S by W with all sail set saw
nothing Obs Lat 1.54 N Long 158.49 W

Monday All of these 24 hours light baffling winds from
Sept the 7 S to S by E and calm fine pleasant weather
Ship heading from S by E to S by W the watch
employed in Ships duty saw nothing
Obs Lat 1.36 N Long 160.12 W

Tuesday All of these 24 hours light winds from S by E
Sept the 8 and pleasant weather Ship heading from
S by E to S by W with all sail set the watch
employed in mending sails saw a Pinback
So Ends Obs Lat 1.06 N Long 160.57 W

Wednesday Commences with light winds and pleasant
Sept the 9 weather Ship heading from S to S by E and
all sail the watch employed in Ships duty
saw nothing Obs Lat 0.19 N Long 161.09 W

Thursday All of these 24 hours light winds from
Sept the 10 S by E and pleasant weather Ship heading
S by E under all sail the watch employed
in mending sails saw nothing
Obs Lat 0.23 N Long 160.45 W

Friday These 24 hours begins with light airs from

Sept the 13 to S by E and pleasant weather Ship heading
from S by E to S by E with all sail set on sail in
sight So Ends Obs Lat 4.43 N Long 160.16 W

Monday These 24 hours begins with light winds
Sept the 14 from S by E and pleasant weather Ship
heading S by E latter a fine breeze from S
the watch employed in mending sails saw
nothing Obs Lat 5.39 N Long 160.10 W

Tuesday Begins with a brisk wind from E and pleasant
Sept the 15 Ship heading S by E middle part fresh breeze
from S by E and squally at 9 A.M. split the
main top gallant sail in a squall uncut at
8 bent another latter part light wind steering
S by E So Ends Obs Lat 7.20 N Long 159.29 W

Wednesday Commences with a fresh breeze from E and
Sept the 16 pleasant weather Ship heading S by E with
all sail set latter part light baffling winds
the watch employed in Ships duty saw nothing
Obs Lat 8.58 N Long 159.11 W

Thursday These 24 hours commences with light winds
Sept the 17 and squally weather Ship heading from
S by E to S by W latter fresh breeze from S by E Ship
heading S
