

Remarks on board of Ship Charles Phelps

Friday All of these 24 hours brisk wind from Sept the 18 S E to S E by S and pleasant weather Ship heading from S to S by W at 9 p m took in flying Jib & Mizzen top gallant Sail at 5 A m Let them again Saw nothing Obs Lat 12.10 S Long 160.20 W

Saturday Commences with a fine breeze from S. Sept the 19 and pleasant weather Ship heading S S Middle and latter baffling winds from S S to S E by S Ship heading from S to S W by S Saw a Sail standing to the N W So ends Obs Lat 13.50 S Long 160.55 W

Sunday Begins with a fresh breeze from S to S E and Sept the 20 pleasant weather Ship heading from S S to S S W with all Sail set Latter part much the same Saw nothing Obs Lat 15.25 S Long 161.33 W

Monday These 24 hours commences with a fresh Sept the 21 breeze from S S to S E and pleasant Ship heading from S E to S S W with all Sail set Latter part lighter winds So ends Saw nothing Obs Lat 17.10 S Long 161.30 W

Tuesday Commences with light winds from S S Sept the 22 and pleasant weather Middle part the wind light & baffling at 5 p m a fresh breeze and squally took in flying Jib & Mizzen top gallant Sail at 6 took in fore in fore & main top gallant Sails & reefed the Mizzen top Sail at 7 wore Ship and took in the bow boat the wind S S Ship heading S S Obs Lat 18.19 S Long 161.16 W

Wednesday All of these 24 hours strong winds from S S Sept the 23 to S S Ship heading to the eastward at 10 P m put one reef in the fore & main top Sails at 5 A m wore Ship heading S Latter part shook the reefs out of the top Sails Saw nothing Obs Lat 18.24 S Long 161.03

Thursday All of these 24 hours strong winds from Sept the 24 S S to S E by S and some squally Ship heading from S by E to S by W at 8 p m single reefed the top Sails at 9 A m shook them out again Saw nothing Obs Lat 19.33 S Long 161.38 W

Friday Commences with strong wind from S to S S Sept the 25 and pleasant Ship heading from S to S S at 9 A m more moderate Let top gallant Sails & flying Jib Saw nothing Obs Lat 20.55 S Long 161.48 W

Saturday These 24 hours commences with a fine breeze Sept the 26 from S by S Ship heading S by S with all Sail set Latter part light wind and very rugged the watch employed in Ships duty Saw nothing Obs Lat 22.29 S Long 162.00 W

Sunday Begins with a breeze from S S to S S and squally Sept the 27 Ship heading S S at 9 P m took in flying Jib and Mizzen top gallant Sail at 10 took in fore & main top gallant Sails at 11 double reefed the top Sails blowing strong at 5 A m made moderate shook the reefs out of the top Sails the winds & tacked Ship heading S S at 9 made all Sail Latter part light baffling some & calm Obs Lat 23.53 S Long 162.48 W Long by Lunar 162.47
