

Remarks on board of Ship Charles Phelps

Monday These 24 hours commences with light winds from S E to S S E and pleasant weather Ship heading S E with all sail set at 8 A M Steered Steered N with a fresh breeze from S S E at 12 kept off N N E for the Island of Koratong Saw a sail to the Seeward So Ends

Obs Lat 22.43 S Long 160.32 W

Tuesday Commences a fresh breeze and pleasant weather wind from S S E Steering N N E at daylight made the Islands of Koratong bearing N E by E distant 15 miles at 10 A M went ashore with 3 boats got off 7 boat loads of wood at 7 P M the boats got on board So Ends lying off and on

Wednesday Begins with light winds from S E at 9 A M. went ashore with 4 boats the distance 10 miles got off 4 boat loads of wood 89 barrels of Sweet Potatoes & some Fruit at 6 got on board and braced forward Ship heading S S W with fresh breeze from S E

Thursday These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze from S E and overcast Ship heading S S W latter part light winds the watch employed in stowing away wood Saw nothing No Obs

Friday Commences with light baffling winds from S E to S S E by E and pleasant Ship heading from S S W to S W by W with all sail set latter part a fresh breeze from S E the watch employed in Ship's duty Saw nothing Obs Lat 23.14 S Long 161.40 W

Saturday Begins with a fresh breeze from S E to S S E at the 3 and pleasant weather Ship heading from S to S S W painted the Starboard quarter boat latter part squally took in flying Jib & Mizzen top gallant sail Saw nothing

Obs Lat 24.51 S Long 162.38 W

Sunday All of these 24 hours fresh breeze from S E to S S E at the 4 and squally Ship heading from S S E to S S W at 8 A M took in flying Jib & Mizzen top gallant sail at 9 P M the main top gallant sail sent it down and bent another at 11 P M that one took in the fore & main Saw nothing

Obs Lat 26.31 S Long 163.10 W

Monday These 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze from S E to S S E and pleasant Ship heading S latter part more moderate ditto top gallant sails and flying Jib Saw nothing So Ends

Obs Lat 28.25 S Long 163.24 W

Tuesday Commences with a fresh breeze from S E at the 6 to S N E and overcast Ship heading from S to S E with all sail set at 1 P M took in flying Jib & Mizzen top gallant sail Saw nothing So Ends

Obs Lat 30.11 S Long 163.00 W

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze from S E to S S E Steering S E with all sail set Middle part light wind from S S E by E and pleasant weather latter part a fresh breeze Saw 2 Kinbacks So Ends

Obs Lat 31.32 S Long 161.41 W
