Thursday Commences with a fresh breeze from
Oct the 8 S & N & and pleasant weather Ship heading
S & at 6 A.M. took in flying Lib. & Mizzen top
gallant sail at 9 took in fore & main top
gallant sails strong breeze from N & and raining
at 3 P.M. double reefed the fore & Mizzen top
sails & one reef in the main at 5 P.M. the rain
N & & raining Obs Lat 33.54 S Long 160.38 W

Friday Begins with a strong breeze from N & and
Oct the 9 thick rainy weather steering S & under
double reef fore & Mizzen top & single
reef courses & Lib at 2 P.M. more moderate
shook one reef out of the top sails saw
nothing so ends Obs Lat 36.14 S

Saturday These 24 hours Begins with a strong breeze
Oct the 10 from N and thick rainy weather Ship
steering S & under the top sails courses
and Lib at 3 P.M. double reefed the top
sails at 6 took in the main sail & Lib
blowing a strong gale from N & so ends
Obs

Sunday Commences with a strong gale from N & &
Oct the 11 and rainy steering S & under double reef top
sails and fore sail at 9 P.M. blowing very
heavy in squalls took in fore & Mizzen top sails and
fore sail close reefed the main top sail & hove the
Ship too at 1 A.M. the wind moderated & Ship
off S & and set double reef top sails at 5 Shook
the reefs out of the top sails and set the main
top gallant sail at 9 A.M. made all sail fine
pleasant weather saw nothing so ends
Obs Lat 39.00 S Long 155.10 W

Monday These 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze from
Oct the 12 N & W and pleasant weather steering S & S
middle & latter part the baffling from N & W
to N & by S so ends saw nothing
Obs Lat 39.56 S Long 152.44 W

Tuesday Commences with light baffling wind
Oct the 13 from N & W to S & W and pleasant
weather steering S by S with all sail set
saw nothing so ends Obs Lat 40.27 S Long 151.09 W

Wednesday Begins with light winds from N & W and
Oct the 14 pleasant steering S by S middle and latter
part fresh gales from N & W steering with
all sail set saw nothing so ends
Obs Lat 41.08 S Long 149.25 W

Thursday These 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze
Oct the 15 from N & W and thick weather with some
rain steering S with all sail set at 2 P.M.
the wind from blowing strong in squalls
furled the main sail & Lib took in top gallant
sails & top mast studding sail at 4 P.M. double
reefed the top sails at 1/2 past 5 close reefed the fore
top sail & took in the Mizzen at 7 close reefed the main
blowing heavy from N & W took up the boats & got the
drugs so ends Obs Lat 41.54 S Long 145.05 W

Friday Commences with a strong gale from N & W
Oct the 16 and squally steering S under close reef fore & main
top sail & fore sail at 1 A.M. it moderated shook
one reef out of the top sails & set the Mizzen top sail at 5
shook all of the reefs out of the top sails at 7 made all sail
latter part light winds Obs Lat 42.02 S Long 142.03 W
