

Ship Charles Phelps of Stonington

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with light
Oct the 28 baffling airs and calms. Steering S by N
thick foggy weather. Latter part a fresh
breeze from N by E and pleasant. So ends
Obs Lat 44.06 S Long 106.20 W

Thursday Begins with a fresh breeze from NW
Oct the 29 and pleasant. Steering S by E under
all sail. Latter part light baffling winds
and fog. Squalls. Saw nothing. So ends
Obs Lat 44.17 S Long 103.25 W

Friday Commences with a light westerly wind.
Oct the 30 and thick weather. Steering S by E with
all sail. Latter part a fresh breeze
from NW to NW and pleasant. Saw
nothing. So ends. Obs Lat 44.25 S Long 100.54 W

Saturday These 24 hours begins with a fresh breeze from
Oct the 31 NW and pleasant. Steering S by E with all
sail. Set at 11 P.M. took in flying Lib & Mizzen
top gallant sail at 2 o'clock took in top mast
studding sail at 1/2 past 4 took in fore & main
top gallant sails. Double reefed the top sail
blowing strong at 1/2 past 4 took in main sail Lib &
Mizzen top sail. Blowing heavy in squalls the
wind hauled to WSW at 5 P.M. Shook a reef out of
the fore & main top sail. So ends
Obs Lat 44.38 S Long 96.28 W

Sunday Commences with a strong gale from WSW
Nov the 1 and pleasant at 9 P.M. Shook the reef
out of the top sails and set main top gallant
sail at 4 o'clock the wind hauled to N. Set top mast
studding sail Mizzen top sail & fore top gallant sail
So ends. Obs Lat 44.23 S Long 92.53 W

Bonnet to the coast of Chili November 1846

Monday Begins with strong westerly winds and pleasant
Nov the 2 Steering S by E. Latter part thick and rainy
at 9 o'clock took in top mast studding sail
and fore top gallant sail. So ends
Obs Lat 44.27 S Long 88.53 W

Tuesday All of these 24 hours brisk winds from WSW
Nov the 3 And thick weather. Steering S by E at 8 a.m.
Set top mast studding sail & fore top gallant
sail. Saw a Gambak. So ends
Obs Lat 44.27 S Long 86.08 W

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with a light breeze
Nov the 4 from W and thick weather. Steering S by E
Latter part light baffling winds from W to NW
and fog. Squalls. Saw nothing. So ends
Obs Lat 44.12 S Long 84.12 W

Thursday Commences with a brisk wind from NW
Nov the 5 Ship heading S by E with all sail. Set thick
dirty weather at 3 o'clock took in flying Lib
fore & Mizzen top gallant sails at 1 P.M. took in
the main top gallant sail. Saw nothing.
So ends. Obs Lat 43.51 S Long 81.53 W

Friday Begins with a fresh breeze from NW and thick
Nov the 6 weather. Ship heading S by E at 9 p.m. double
reefed the top sails at 2 o'clock blowing strong
put the close reef main top sail & fore sail at
5 the wind hauled to NW by W and moderate
Set double reef top sails at 2 P.M. Blowed
on again. Hove the ship too under close reef
main top sail at sun down. Blowing heavy from
NW. So ends. Obs Lat 44.15 S Long 79.48 W
