top mast and top gallant Shudding sail
Latter part moderate the SW set the lower
Shudding sail the watch employed in making
Ratting stuff So ends

Saturday All of these 24 hours light baffling winds
Feb the 13 from SE to S and pleasant course
NW at 8 all sail set the watch employed in
working on the rigging So ends

Sunday All of these 24 hours light baffling winds
Feb the 14 from S to SE and pleasant weather
Steering NW with all sail set saw
nothing

Obs Lat 27.30 S Long 35.49 W

Monday Begins with light winds from S and
Feb the 15 pleasant Ship heading NW at 8 with all
sail set Latter part baffling wind
and squally weather Ship heading from
NW to NE some rain So ends

Obs Lat 26.35 S Long 35.50

Tuesday These 24 hours begin with light winds
Feb the 16 from the Northward with thunder
lightning and rain took in top gallant
sails middle part strong breeze from NW
Ship heading at 10 AM the wind hauled to NE
were Ship heading NE at 11 the watch employed
in washing Ship

Homeward Bound February 1847

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze
Feb the 17 from N to NE and squally with rain at 11
PM Split the main top gallant sail took
at 12 double reefed the fore & main top sails
at 2 double reefed the main blowing strong in squalls
middle & Latter part strong winds and very squally
Ship under double reef top sails & courses heading from
NE to SE the wind from N to NE So ends

No Obs

Thursday Commences with with strong winds from
Feb the 18 NW to N and squally Ship heading from
NW to SE middle more moderate shook
the reef out of the top sails and set the Gib sent
down the main top gallant sail & repaired it
Latter part pleasant all sail set So ends

Obs Lat 25.04 S Long 33.14 W

Friday Begins with a light breeze from NW at 5 AM
Feb the 19 and pleasant Ship heading from NW at 8
to SE with all sail set middle and
Latter part much the same the watch
employed in fitting rigging So ends

Obs Lat 24.22 S Long 32.02 W

Saturday All of these 24 hours light baffling winds
Feb the 20 from NW to NE and calm Ship heading
from NW to S the watch employed in fitting rigging

Obs Lat 24.04 S Long 31.20 W

Sunday All of these 24 light baffling winds from
Feb the 21 NW to SE and pleasant Ship heading
from NW by N to SE with all sail set
So ends

Obs Lat 23.4 S Long 31.47 W
