

Remarks on Board of Ship Charles Phelps

Thursday These 24 hours commences with brisk winds
Mar the 4 from S S E and pleasant middle and
latter part light winds and squally
at 2 P.M. set the lower studding sail the
wind S E So Ends

Friday Commences with light baffling winds
Mar the 5 and squally with rain ship heading
from N by W to N by E middle part brisk
wind from E by S to S S E latter part wind
S E steering N by W with all sail set 2 sail
in sight employed in chasing ship outside
So Ends Ob Lat 10.50 S Long 34.12 W

Saturday Begins with brisk trade winds from S E
Mar the 6 and pleasant steering N by W with
all sail set at 9 A.M. saw the land
bearing W hauled up steered along the
land the watch employed in ship's duty
So Ends Ob Lat 9.12 S Long 34.53 W

Sunday These 24 hours commences with light
Mar the 7 trade winds from S S E and pleasant
steering along the land at 12 P.M. luffed
too and lay with the main top sail aback
untill daylight wore off and steered along
shore at 11 A.M. got off abreast of Pernambuco
latter part laying off and on saw a Whaling
Barge go in and anchor and saw one lying
there to anchor So Ends

Stonington Homeward Bound March 1847

Monday Commences with brisk trade winds and
Mar the 8 pleasant ship laying off and on at Pernambuco
at 7 A.M. lowered 2 boats and went ashore at 5
P.M. returned brought off 3 Hds of Beef 3 cts of bread
some small stores and some oranges placed
forward and stood off shore heading S E

Tuesday Begins with light winds from S S E to S E
Mar the 9 ship heading N by E with rain squalls at 1 P.M.
of N by E latter part brisk trade winds from
S S E to S E steering N by E with all sail
set the watch employed in ship's duty So Ends
the land in sight Ob Lat 6.38 S Long 34.35 W

Wednesday All of these 24 hours brisk trade
Mar the 10 winds from S E and pleasant steering
from N to N by E employed in painting
ship saw nothing So Ends
Ob Lat 4.17 S Long 35.31 W

Thursday All of these 24 hours light trade winds
Mar the 11 from E to S E and pleasant weather
steering N with all sail set employed
in painting ship So Ends
Ob Lat 2.37 S Long 36.05 W

Friday All of these 24 hours light winds from
Mar the 12 E to S E and squally with rain steering
N with all sail set saw nothing
Ob Lat 1.18 S Long 37.12 W

Saturday Commences with light winds and squally with
Mar the 13 plenty of rain steering N latter part fresh
breeze from E by S to S E and rainy steering N by W
saw a merchant barge standing to the northward
So Ends
