

Ship Charles Phelps Outward Bound

Friday July 16th 1847

Lively breeze from the N by N and good weather. Steering S by W with all sail set. Making sun gear and at work on the rigging. Middle part - light winds. Latter part saw 2 sail steering westward. Setting up rigging 20.02

Saturday July 17th

Lively breeze and cloudy. Steering S by W with all sail set. Making sun gear and at work on the rigging. Middle part - light winds. Latter part breeze. Saw 11 sails steering S. Setting up rigging 17.29 26.10

Sunday July 18th

Lively breeze and smoke weather. Steering S by W all sail set. At 4 light S^r Anthony bearing E distant 12.5 miles. At work on the rigging. Middle part light winds and baffling. Latter part steady breeze from the E and showery. Steering S. Saw 3 sail bound 15.10 25.40

Monday July 19th

Lively winds from the E and good weather. All sail set steering S. Saw 2 sail bound and a ship bound N. Middle part - light winds from the E. Latter part breeze a little and hauls to E & E. At work on rigging 11.52

Tuesday July 20th

Lively breeze from E & E and good weather. Steering S by E with all sail set. At work on the rigging. Saw a ship & sail in sight steering S. Middle part - light winds. Latter part almost calm. Saw 2 sail. At work on the rigging. Making sun gear and rigged out a Larboard whisker boom 11.06

Wednesday July 21st

Light air from the S and fine weather. Steering S by E all sail set. At work on the rigging. Middle part - showery. Latter part baffling winds and showery. Broke out coffee and at work on rope gear 11.20

Thursday July 22nd

Calm. At 2 a light breeze from the N and showery. Rigged out a whisker. Saw 1 sail steering S and on S. Middle part - wind from the N by N. Latter part a lively breeze from S.W. heading S & E by the wind. At work on rigging 9.01 23.40

Friday July 23rd

Lively breeze from S.W. An English barge in sight. At work on rigging. At 3 the wind came out strong from N by W with heavy rain. Steering S by W. Set S & M. Steer sail. Middle part - at 4 calm. Latter part - light baffling winds. At work on the rigging 8.07 23.20

Ship Charles Phelps Bound to Chili

Saturday July 24th 1847

Light winds from the N and good weather. At 3 some hauls to the S. Heading by the wind to the E & E with all sail set. The English barge astern. Middle part at 10 wind fresh to the S by E. Latter part - saw 1 ship and headed N.W. At 1 wind fresh again. Hauled to the S.E. Latter part - ruffled. Sent down Miz & I sail to alter it 1.50 25.01

Sunday July 25th

Strong breeze from the S.W. and rough weather. Heading by the wind S by E all sail set. At 2 sent the Miz & I sail. The barge in sight on our weather beam heading westward. Middle part at 6 hauled to the N. Moderate. At 12 hauled again to the S.E. Light winds for the latter part. Nothing seen 1.20

Monday July 26th

Light winds from the S.W. and fine weather. Steering by the wind S by E with all sail set. At 6 a sail on the lee bow. Middle part wind S.W. Latter part the same and good weather. At work on rigging and sun gear 6.46

Tuesday July 27th

Light winds from the S.W. and showers. Standing by the wind S by E. Middle part squally. Latter part strong breeze from the S. At 9 hauled to N.W. & sail in sight. On a whaler. Making sun gear 6.23 19.40

Wednesday July 28th

Strong winds from the S and ruffled. Steering by the wind N.W. with all sail set. Making sun gear and at work on the rigging. Middle part the same. Latter part breeze a little. On sail in sight. Making sail mat 5.13 20.32

Thursday July 29th

Strong breeze from S by E and good weather. Standing by the wind S.W. by W. Took in Miz & I sail. Jotting. Middle part good weather. Wind S. Set Miz & I sail. Latter part wind hauls to S.S.E. Fixing banks and jotting 3.38 22.10

Friday July 30th

Lively winds from S.S.E. and good weather. All sail set. heading S.W. by the corner. Fixing banks and jotting. Middle part - light winds from S. Latter part wind S.S.E. Painted waist boat and jotting 11.47

Saturday July 31st

Lively breeze from S.S.E. and good weather. All sail set heading S.W. Two sail bound. Middle part - wind S by E. Course S.W. Latter part the same. Painting boat and jotting. A sail steering Southward. Lat. South - 0.24 24.45
