

Chas Phelps Bound to the Sandwich Is.
Saturday Aug 26th 1848

Light winds from the NW with light showers of rain
bleaking S.E. the wind with all sail set. At work on the
rigging. Middle part smart breeze from the S. Latter
part strong breeze from S.W. and squally. 39.26

Sunday Aug 27th Strong breeze from S.W. S. and
squally. All sail set heading S.E. Splitting top gal. sail.
Mended it and bent a new one. Middle part the wind
and weather the same. Latter part smart breeze and fine
weather. Nothing seen 37.66

Monday August 28th Light breeze from the S.W.
and fine weather. All sail set heading S.E. the wind to the
S.E. Moderate some. Nothing seen. Middle part the wind
and weather the same. Latter part the wind hauled N.W. S.
set the stunsails. Steering S. Employed in stowing down cask
in the fore hold and breaking up pipe shoals. Heads 3.00
35.09

Tuesday Aug 29th Light winds from the N.W. S. and fine weather
all sail set steering S. Employed in setting up pipe
shoals for water. Nothing seen. At 6 wind shifted to the N.
and showery. Middle part good weather. At 4 wind hauled N.E.
Latter part light winds and fine weather. All sail set. Course S.W. 33.56

Wednesday Aug 30th Light winds from the N.E.
and fine weather. All sail set steering S.W. Setting up
shoals and jolting. Middle part moderate winds from
the N.W. S. and showery. Latter part wind N.E. by E. and
squally. Setting up shoals 33.19

Thursday Aug 31st Light winds from the N.E.
and squally. All sail set to advantage. Steering S.W. Mizen
top mast stay parted. Fitted another. Setting up shoals. Middle
part strong breeze and squally showery weather. Latter part
dark cloudy weather. All sail set. Course S.W. Employed
in setting up shoals and bundling tone 29.30

Chas Phelps Bound to Morocco
Friday September 1st 1848

Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather. All sail
set staying S.W. Employed in setting up shoals and
bundling tone. Middle part the wind veered and hauled
from N.W. to E. and showery. Latter part smart breeze and
dark weather. A light shower. Bundling tone 27.18
146.50

Saturday Sept 2nd Light breeze and good
weather. All sail set to advantage. Steering S.W. Employed
in bundling tone and marking it. Middle part strong
breeze and squally. Steering S.W. by S. Latter part lively
winds and good weather. Bundling tone 25.69

Sunday Sept 3rd Light breeze and good weather
all sail set steering S.W. by S. Finished bundling tone 145 bundles.
Middle part strong breeze and squally rainy weather. Latter
part lively winds and good weather. Nothing seen 23.40

Monday Sept 4th Light breeze and good weather. All sail set steering
S.W. by S. Nothing seen. Middle part wind veered and hauled
from E. to N.E. Latter part light wind and fine weather. 21.13
153.08

Tuesday Sept 5th Light breeze and fine weather. All
sail set steering S.W. S. Nothing seen. At 4 steered S.W. Middle
part showery. Latter part lively breeze and good weather.
At 4 steered S.W. by S. At 6 saw a ship steering Westward. At 8 saw
the E. end of Morocco. At 12 heard South 21.18

Wednesday Sept 6th Light breeze and good
weather. All sail set steering S.W. by S. for the passage.
At 7 running down between Morocco and Morocco. Middle
part by me off and on. Latter part light air. Standing in
for Morocco anchorage. At 5 down haul and hove. At 6 drift
length in 17 fathoms of water. 50 fathoms scope.
Four ships lying here. Betty Williams. Rickman. Phifford
and Rochester
