

Ship Charles Phelps Bound for Hongkong
Sunday Jan 13th 1850.

Light winds from the N.W. and fine weather. All day
sail & following 6. Four sail in sight. A heavy swell
from the S. At 3 small breeze. At 5 passed Montauk
point. Heading by the time 10 by 11. Look in W. gallant sail
and fly jib. At 12 great sail & strong breeze haul
to N.W. by 12 and on Hongkong after part
strong breeze. At 12 took a pilot and voyage at through
the race to the end of Fisher Island. Very light winds

Monday Jan 14th Very light winds from the
N. All sail set working into the breeze. At 12 came
to an anchor in 4 fathoms of water. 15 fathoms depth
New London light bearing N distant 12 miles. At 1
strong breeze. Weather part the same

Tuesday Jan 15th Strong breeze from N.W. & N.E.
and clear weather. At anchor.
